

ORDER

Having read the papers filed on behalf of the Applicants, it is ordered as follows:

- This application is enrolled in terms of Tribunal Rule 10(7). It proceeds as an urgent interdict in terms of Tribunal Rule 12 (2). The normal forms and service provided in Tribunal Rules are dispensed with.
- 2. Pending final determination of civil proceedings for the recovery of damages or losses and disgorgement of secret profits derived from unlawful ("the proceedings"), contracts. if any, main be instituted against the First Respondent by the Applicant in the above-mentioned Tribunal within 60 court days of the granting of this order, the Second Respondent, Liberty Life Group, is interdicted and restrained from making payment to the First Respondent, Mr Marubini Ramatsekisa ("Mr Ramatsekisa"), or any other party, any amount in respect of Mr Ramatsekisa's pension benefits held under membership number M311129B.
- The applicant is directed to serve a copy of the application together with this order on the Respondents.
- The parties' attention is drawn to the annotation the presiding Judge made on Caselines.

- 5. The Respondents are granted leave in terms of Tribunal Rule 12(9), on notice to the Applicants and/ or other interested parties, to set the matter down for reconsideration of this order.
- 6. The costs of this application are reserved.
