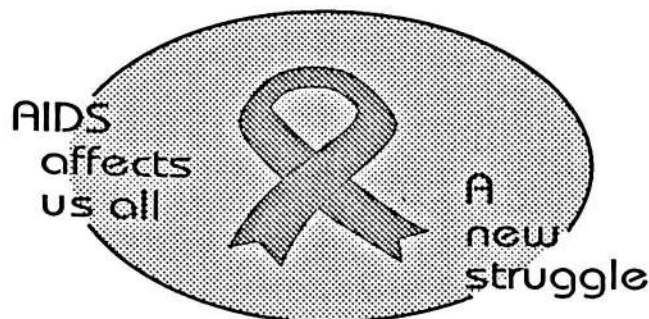

SCHEDULE***Substitution of regulation 6***

1. Regulation 6 is substituted by the following:

"6. The board may not accept any application for special legalisation under regulation 2 after 31 July 2001."

No. 18**11 May 2001****DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AFFAIRS, ENVIRONMENT AND TOURISM****EASTERN CAPE TOURISM BOARD ACT, 1995 (ACT No. 5 OF 1995)****INVITATION FOR NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES TO THE EASTERN CAPE TOURISM BOARD**

1. All interested parties and individuals are hereby invited in terms of section 4 (2) (a) of the Eastern Cape Tourism Board Act, 1995 (Act No. 5 of 1995), to nominate candidates for, or to apply for membership to the Eastern Cape Tourism Board.
2. The Board members will serve for a period of not more than five years to be determined by the Member of the Executive Council responsible for tourism.
3. Attention is drawn to section 4 (1) of the Act, which provides that the Board shall, subject to section 15 (2), consist of not fewer than seven and not more than 11 members, of whom—
 - (a) one shall be an officer of the State employed by the Department of Economic Affairs, Environment and Tourism;
 - (b) one shall be an officer in the service of the state dealing with environmental affairs (with an alternate member);
 - (c) at least four shall be persons who are actively engaged, or who possess special knowledge or experience, in the tourist industry;
 - (d) not more than six may be appointed with the view of making the Board democratic, open, transparent and representative of the geographic area comprising the Province as a whole.
4. A nomination or application must—
 - (a) be accompanied by a comprehensive curriculum vitae; and
 - (b) contain a motivation, including the qualifications, experience and qualities of the nominee or applicant that will enable him or her to discharge his or her functions of the Board efficiently.

5. Names and full particulars of two referees must be provided.
6. Full names, address, telephone and fax number of the nominee and/or applicant must be provided.
