

# **PROVINCE OF THE EASTERN CAPE**

## OFFICE OF THE PREMIER

REMUNERATION OF PUBLIC OFFICE BEARERS ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 20 OF 1998): DETERMINATION OF SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES OF MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL AND MEMBERS OF THE PROVINCIAL LEGISLATURE

I, Nosimo Balindlela, Premier of the Province of the Eastern Cape, acting in terms of section 6(3) of the Remuneration of Public Office Bearers Act, 1998 (Act No. 20 of 1998)(hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), having regard to Presidential Proclamation No. 48 of 2005 contained in Gazette No. 28010 of 7 September 2005, hereby determine that –

- (1) the annual salaries and allowances of the various grades of office bearers mentioned in Column 1 of Schedule 1 shall be as set out in Columns 2, 3 and 4 of Schedule 1 with effect from 01 April 2005, subject to section 6(7) of the Act;
- (2) Column 4 of Schedule 1 (Notch 3) applies to a re-elected member who at any time has occupied his or her current office, or an office in the same or a higher grade according to Column 1 of Schedule 2, for a period of at least 24 months in total, before or after 14 April 2005;
- (3) Column 3 of Schedule 1 (Notch 2) applies to all re-elected members other than those referred to in paragraph (2) above. When a re-elected member to whom Column 3 of Schedule 1 applies has held his or her current office, or an office in the same or a higher grade according to Column 1, for a period of 24 months in total,, Column 4 of Schedule 1 (Notch 3) becomes applicable to that member;
- (4) Column 2 of Schedule 1 (Notch 1) applies to all members of the Executive Council and members of the Provincial Legislatures who are not re-elected members;

- (5) for the purpose of calculating the period of 24 months referred to in paragraphs (2) and (3), a re-elected member who-
  - (a) was a member of the Provincial Legislature on 13 April 2004, and
  - (b) pursuant to the elections of 14 April 2004, was designated by the Electoral Commission as a member of the Provincial Legislature,

is regarded to have continued to occupy the position occupied by him or her on 13 April 2004 until so designated or appointed;

- (6) in terms of section 6(4) of the Act, I further determine the amount of R40 000.00 per annum as that portion of the remuneration of an office bearer mentioned in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to which section 8(1)(d) of the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962), applies;
- (7) except for the salaries and allowances provided for in this Notice, the office-bearers mentioned in Column 1 of Schedule 1 are not entitled to any other remuneration, whether directly or indirectly, in respect of the offices held by them;
- (8) in this Notice, unless the context indicated otherwise, any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act, the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 108 of 1996, or the relevant Rules and Orders contemplated in section 116 of the Constitution, bears that meaning, and -
  - (a) "member of the Legislature" means a member of the Provincial Legislature; and
  - (b) "re-elected member" means a member of the Legislature
    - who at any time before 14 April 2004 occupied an office in Column 2 of Schedule 2; and
    - (ii) whose service in any one or more of those offices has not been interrupted at any time for a continuous period of more than 24 months; and

(9) Provincial Notice No. 51, published in Government Gazette No. 1244 of 12 November 2004, is hereby repealed.
