5. Allocation Criteria	Each municipality will receive an amount as allocated.
6. Monitoring mechanisms	(a) Quarterly reports to Department of Provincial and Local Government on the status quo of the process

7. Projected Life	± 1 year or until such time as all final reviewed Integrated Development Plans have been submitted to the Member of the Executive Council.
8. Payment Schedule	Payment will only be made according to conditions set in paragraph 4.

In terms of Section 17(1) of the Division of Revenue Act, 2003 (Act No. 7 of 2003), the Provincial Treasury hereby publishes the information set out in Schedule 1 which relates to the allocation of the amounts as stated in Schedule 2 relating to the allocation of funds out of the Provincial Revenue Fund by the accounting officer of the Department of Local Government and Housing to municipalities.

#### **SCHEDULE 1**

## **TOWN PLANNING SCHEMES (TPS)**

2004

1. Transferring Provincial Department	Department of Local Government and Housing
2. Purpose.	To assist municipalities financially with the compilation of town-planning schemes in order to have proper control over land use developments
3. Measurable outputs.	The provision of limited financial assistance to municipalities with regard to the compilation of TPS.  To afford those municipalities the opportunities to make use of technical experts in specialized fields.
4. Conditions.	The municipality can only use the financial assistance for the compilation of a TPS.  The municipality must submit to the Department a business plan on how the funds are going to be used.  The Council must adopt the draft TPS.  The proposal to be presented by the Municipal Manager with the assistance of the consultant before the Free State Townships Board.  The Municipal Manager and the Mayor

	certifies that the expenditure was spent for the compilation of the TPS and that sufficient evidence to substantiate all payments is available on request to the Province. It has not yet been decided which municipalities will benefit from this assistance. Beneficiary municipalities and the respective amounts will be considered in due course when the specific needs have been assessed.
5. Allocation criteria.	The benefiting municipalities will receive funds allocated in relation to their size and financial needs. The availability of an existing TPS and if existing the standard of it will also be taken into consideration. It will be attempted to address the problems in all district municipalities.
6. Monitoring mechanisms.	Quarterly reports regarding the progress of the compilation of the TPS will have to be submitted to the Land Development Directorate.
7. Projected life.	Not to be determine
8. Payment schedule.	The amounts agreed as per criteria will be paid once off to the municipality or in terms of the business plan.
9. Reason not incorporated in equitable share.	According to section 154(1) of the Constitution the national and provincial governments, by legislative and other measures, must support and strengthen the capacity of municipalities to manage their own affairs, to exercise their powers and to perform their functions.
