#### ELECTORAL COMMISSION

#### **ELECTION TIMETABLE**

The Electoral Commission hereby gives notice that it has in terms of section 11 of the Local Government: Municipal Electoral Act, 2000, compiled the election timetable set out below to apply to the municipal by-elections to be held on 21 July 2010 in respect of Ward 1 of the Mohokare [FS163] Municipality and Ward 28 and 31 of the Mangaung [FS172] Municipality and Ward 13 of the Dihlabeng [FS192] Municipality and Ward 1,2,3 and 4 of the Naledi [FS171] Municipality as proclaimed by Provincial Notice number 46 of 2010 as published in the Provincial Gazette No. 46 of the Free State Province respectively, dated 18 June 2010. A reference to "section" in this election timetable is a reference to that section in the Local Government: Municipal Electoral Act, 2000 (Act No. 27 of 2000).

#### Cut-off time for act to be performed

1 An act required in terms of this Act to be performed by not later than a date in the election timetable must be performed before 17:00 on that date, unless otherwise specified.

#### Certification of the voters' roll

2 By 25 June 2010 the chief electoral officer must certify the segments of the voters' roll for the voting districts to be used in the byelections in terms of section 6(2)(a).

#### Notice that lists of addresses of voting stations are available for inspection

3 By 25 June 2010 the chief electoral officer must give notice that copies of a list of voting stations and their addresses will be available for inspection at the office of the Commission's local representative in terms of section 19(5).

#### Notice of route of mobile voting stations

4 If the Commission decides to use mobile voting stations in the by-elections, the Commission must by 25 June 2010 give notice of the route, including the locations and estimated times of stopping of each mobile voting station in terms of section 22(1).

#### Cut-off date for nomination of ward candidates to contest an election

5 By not later than 01 July 2010 at 17h00, the nomination of a person to contest the by-election in a municipality as a ward candidate must be submitted to the Commission's local representative on a prescribed form and in the prescribed manner in terms of section 17(1).

#### Cut-off date for compilation and certification of ward candidate lists

6 By 08 July 2010 the Commission must compile for each ward a list of ward candidates, certify those lists for that by-election, and keep copies of the lists available at the office of the Commission's local representative in terms of section 18 (1).

#### Cut-off date for issuing certificates

7 By 12 July 2010 the Commission must issue to each ward candidate contesting the by-election, a prescribed certificate in terms of section 18(1)(d).
