SCHEDULE

In terms of section 18(3) of the Local Government: Municipal Structures Act, 1998 (Act No. 117 of 1998), the MEC responsible for local government has determined that the municipal council consists of 19 councillors.

After having consulted the Independent Electoral Commission, The Municipal Demarcation Board has delimited the municipality into 10 wards in terms of Schedule 1 of the Act.
