



It is hereby notified that the Premier has assented to the following Act that is hereby published for general information:

**No. 6 of 2006: Gauteng Liquor Amendment Act, 2006**

**ACT**

To amend the Gauteng Liquor Act, 2003 so as to amend the definition of "shebeen"; and to determine the date of commencement of the amendment.

**B**E IT ENACTED by the Gauteng Provincial Legislature as follows:—

**Amendment of section 1 of Act 2 of 2003**

1. Section 1 of the Gauteng Liquor Act 2 of 2003 is hereby amended by the substitution for the definition of "shebeen" of the following definition: 5

"*shebeen*" means any unlicensed operation whose main business is liquor and sells less than sixty (60) cases of beer per week;"

**Short title and commencement**

2. This Act is called the Gauteng Liquor Amendment Act, 2006, and comes into operation on 05 December 2006. 10
