ACT

To repeal the Gauteng Youth Commission Act, 2005; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

BE IT ENACTED by the Gauteng Provincial Legislature, as follows:—

1. Repeal of Act 2 of 2005

The Gauteng Youth Commission Act, 2005 (Act No. 2 of 2005), is hereby repealed.

2. Short title and commencement

This Act is called Gauteng Youth Commission Repeal Act, 2009, and comes into operation on a date to be fixed by the Premier by proclamation in the Gazette.
