

NOTICE 6033 OF 2000**DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT
PLANNING & LOCAL GOVERNMENT****LOCAL GOVERNMENT: MUNICIPAL STRUCTURES
ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 117 OF 1998)**

BY the powers vested in me in terms of section 14(5) of the Local Government: Municipal Structures Act, 1998, I, Trevor George Fowler, Member of the Executive Council responsible for local government in the Province of Gauteng, make the following transitional arrangements as set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

TRANSITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS

With effect from the date of publication hereof, no municipality shall –

- (a) alter its staff establishment;
- (b) appoint or promote staff or fill a vacancy;
- (c) alter, regrade or upgrade its posts structure;
- (d) increase its salaries or wages, except where salary and wage increases have or are being negotiated by the Bargaining Chamber;
- (e) dispose of or acquire any fixed assets, except for items in the approved capital expenditure budget;
- (f) conclude any contract with a duration of longer than three months or renew any such contracts, except for items in the approved capital expenditure budget;
- (g) spend or commit any reserve capital, except for items in the approved expenditure budget;
- (h) borrow external funds, except for items in the approved expenditure budget.

Provided that the MEC may, upon application by a municipality in consultation with the relevant section 14(5) committee, exempt such a municipality from any provision of this clause with respect to a particular matter. A separate motivated application must be submitted in respect of each exemption required.
