LOCAL AUTHORITY NOTICE 1828

EKURHULENI METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY

DECLARATION AS APPROVED TOWNSHIP

In terms of Section 103 of the Town Planning and Townships Ordinance, 15 of 1986, the Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality hereby declares Bartlett Extension 96 Township to be an approved township subject to the conditions set out in the schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

STATEMENT OF THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE APPLICATION MADE BY GARADOX INVESTMENTS (PTY) LTD (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE OWNER) UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF PARTS A AND C UNDER CHAPTER 3 OF THE TOWN PLANNING AND TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 15 OF 1986, FOR PERMISSION TO ESTABLISH A TOWNSHIP ON PORTIONS 1003 OF THE FARM KLIPFONTEIN 83 IR HAS BEEN GRANTED:

CONDITIONS OF ESTABLISHMENT

1.1 NAME

The name of the township shall be Bartlett Extension 96.

1.2 DESIGN

The township shall consist of erven and the street as indicated on the Surveyor General Plan SG No. 7166/2008.

1.3 DISPOSAL OF EXISTING CONDITIONS OF TITLE

All erven shall be made subject to existing conditions of title and servitudes, if any.

1.4 DEMOLISION OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES

The township owners shall at their own expense cause all existing buildings and structures situated within the building line reserves, side spaces, or over common boundaries to be demolished to the satisfaction of the local authority, if and when required by the local authority to do so. In addition hereto all structures on Erf 1203 Impala Park shall be demolished within six months from the date of the establishment of the township.

1.5 REMOVAL OR REPLACEMENT OF MUNICIPAL SERVICES

If, by reason of the establishment of the township, it should become necessary to remove or replace any existing municipal services, the cost thereof shall be borne by the township owner.

1.6 OBLIGATIONS WITH REGARD TO ESSENTIAL ENGINEERING SERVICES

The township owner shall within such period as the local authority may determine, fulfil their obligations in respect of the provision of engineering services as previously agreed upon between the township owner and the local authority.

1.7 ACCESS

Ingress and egress to and from the township shall be to the satisfaction of the Executive Director: Roads, Transport and Civil Works Department.

1.8 ENDOWMENT

The township owner shall, in terms of the provisions of Section 98(2) and (3) of the Town Planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986, pay to the local authority an endowment of R72 871.91 (VAT included), which amount shall be used by the local authority for the construction of roads and stormwater drainage in or for the township.

Such endowment shall be payable in accordance with the provisions of Section 81 read with Section 95 of the aforesaid ordinance.

1.9 SERVITUDES

A sub-station servitude must be registered to the satisfaction of the Are Manger: Electricity Services simultaneously with the construction of the first building in the township.

2.10 ERF 1203 IMPALA PARK

All existing structures must be demolished to the satisfaction of the local authority within six months after proclamation of the township.

CONDITIONS OF TITLE

All erven shall be subject to the following conditions imposed by the local authority in terms of the provisions of the Town Planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986:-

2.1 ALL ERVEN

- (a) The erf is subject to a servitude, 2m wide, in favour of the local authority, for sewerage and other municipal purposes, along any two boundaries other than a street boundary, and in the case of a panhandle erf, an additional servitude for municipal purposes 2m wide across the access portion of the erf when required by the local authority: Provided that the local authority may dispense with any such servitude.
- (b) No building or other structure shall be erected within the aforesaid servitude area and no large-rooted trees shall be planted within the area of such servitude or within 2m thereof.
- (c) The local authority shall be entitled to deposit temporarily on the land adjoining the aforesaid servitude such material as may be excavated by it during the course of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works as it, in its discretion, may deem necessary, and shall further be entitled to reasonable access to the said land for the aforesaid purposes subject to any damage done during the process of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works being made good by the local authority.
- (d) Erf 1002

The erf is subject to a perpetual right of way servitude in favour of Erf 1003, 10 metres wide, along the western boundary.

(e) Erf 1003

The erf is entitled to a right of way servitude over Erf 1002.

BOKSBURG AMENDMENT SCHEME 1638
