DECLARATION OF RIETVALLEIRAND EXTENSION 49 AS APPROVED TOWNSHIP

In terms of section 103 of the Town-planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance No 15 of 1986), the City of Tshwane hereby declares the township of Rietvalleirand Extension 49 to be an approved township, subject to the conditions as set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE APPLICATION MADE BY THE TRUSTEES FOR THE TIME BEING OF THE ALZA CORPORATION TRUST IN TERMS OF THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER III: PART C OF THE TOWN-PLANNING AND TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1986 (ORDINANCE NO 15 OF 1986), FOR PERMISSION TO ESTABLISH A TOWNSHIP ON PORTION 54 OF THE FARM WATERKLOOF NO 360JR, PROVINCE OF GAUTENG, HAS BEEN GRANTED

CONDITIONS OF ESTABLISHMENT

1.1 NAME

The name of the township shall be Rietvalleirand Extension 49.

1.2 DESIGN

The township shall consist of erven and streets as indicated on General Plan SG No 7600/2006.

1.3 DISPOSAL OF EXISTING CONDITIONS OF TITLE

All erven shall be made subject to existing conditions and servitudes, if any, including the reservation of the rights to minerals.

1.4 ENDOWMENT

Payable to the City of Tshwane.

The township owner shall pay to the City of Tshwane as endowment a total amount of **R92 000,00** which amount shall be used by the City of Tshwane for the acquisition of land for park and/or public open space purposes.

The said endowment amount shall be payable in accordance with the provisions of section 81 of the Town-planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance 15 of 1986).

1.5 REMOVAL OR REPLACEMENT OF MUNICIPAL SERVICES

Should it become necessary to move or replace any existing municipal services as a result of the establishment of the township, the cost thereof shall be borne by the township owner.

1.6 DEMOLITION OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES

When required by the City of Tshwane to do so, the township owner shall at his own expense cause to be demolished to the satisfaction of the City of Tshwane all existing buildings and structures situated within building line reserves and side spaces or over common boundaries, or dilapidated structures.

1.7 REMOVAL OF LITTER

The township owner shall at his own expense have all litter within the township area removed to the satisfaction of the City of Tshwane, when required to do so by the City of Tshwane.

1.8 REMOVAL AND/OR REPLACEMENT OF ESKOM POWER LINES

Should it become necessary to remove and/or replace any existing power lines of Eskom as a result of the establishment of the township, the cost thereof shall be borne by the township owner.

1.9 REMOVAL AND/OR REPLACEMENT OF TELKOM SERVICES

Should it become necessary to remove and/or replace any existing TELKOM services as a result of the establishment of the township, the cost thereof shall be borne by the township owner.

1.10 COMPLIANCE WITH CONDITIONS IMPOSED BY DACE

The township owner shall at his own expense comply with all the conditions imposed, by which the Gauteng Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Environment including if applicable those by which exemption has been granted from compliance with regulations No 1182 and 1183 promulgated in terms of sections 21, 22 and 26 of the Environmental Conservation Act, (Act 73 of 1989) for the development of this township.

1.11 THE DEVELOPER'S OBLIGATIONS

1.11.1 ASSOCIATION AND STATUTES

The developer must register a Section 21 Company (homeowners' association) in terms of the provisions of the Companies Act, 1973 (Act 61 of 1973). A copy of the registered Deed of Association (CM4) and the Company's Statutes must be submitted to the City of Tshwane.

The Association and Statutes must clearly state that the main objective of the homeowners' association is the maintenance of the internal engineering services of the development (i.e. water, sewerage, electricity, and the road and storm water sewers). The developer is deemed to be a member of the Section 21 Company, with all the rights and obligations of an ordinary member, until the last erf has been transferred.

1.11.2 PROVISION OF ENGINEERING DRAWINGS

The developer must submit to the City of Tshwane complete engineering drawings in respect of internal sewers and sewer connection points and complete engineering drawings in respect of the internal road and storm water sewers as well as water and electricity services, prior to the commencement of the construction of the said services.

1.11.3 PROVISION OF A CERTIFICATE BY A PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER

Before any erf is transferred, the City of Tshwane must be provided with a certificate by a Professional Engineer for water, sewerage, electricity, and the internal road and storm water sewers, in which is certified that the internal engineering services have been completed and that the engineers accept liability for the services. The Municipality may at its own discretion allow an exception in respect of the internal road and storm water sewers. If this is the case, the developer must give the Municipality an undertaking that the developer will complete this service on or before a certain date and must provide the Municipality with a guarantee issued by a recognised financial institution.

No building plans will be approved before the services are completed and (if applicable) taken over by the divisions of the Service Delivery Department.

1.11.4 MAINTENANCE PERIOD AND GUARANTEE

A maintenance period of 12 (twelve) months commences when the last of the internal engineering services (i.e. water, sewerage, electricity, and the road and storm water sewers) have been completed. The developer must furnish the Section 21 Company with a maintenance guarantee, issued by a recognised financial institution, in respect of poor workmanship and/or materials with regard to the civil engineering services and the electricity service, which guarantee must be for an amount that is equal to 5% of the contract cost of the civil services and 10% of the contract cost of the electrical services, and proof of this must be submitted to the City of Tshwane.

1.11.5 APPROVAL OF BUILDING PLANS

No building plans will be approved before the services are completed and (if applicable) taken over by the divisions of the Service Delivery Department.

1.11.6 TRANSFER OF LAND TO THE SECTION 21 COMPANY (HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION)

Erf 748 shall be transferred to the homeowners' association (Section 21 Company), within a period of 6 (six) months after proclamation of the township or prior to the first transfer of the first erf in the township which ever the sooner, by and at the expense of the township owner.

A servitude for access and municipal services shall be registered over Erf 748 in favour of the erven in the township.

1.11.7 ERVEN 734 UP TO AND INCLUDING 747

Upon transfer, the owner of the erf must automatically become a member of the Section 21 Company and remain a member until he or she ceases to be the registered owner of that erf, which condition must be included in the title deed of the portion.

1.11.8 CONDITIONS IN FAVOUR OF THE SECTION 21 COMPANY

The following servitudes/conditions in favour of the Section 21 Company must notarially be executed and registered in the Office of the Registrar of Deeds before or simultaneously with the transfer of an erf in the township:

ERVEN 734 UP TO AND INCLUDING 747:

- (i) The erven shall be subject to a servitude, 2 m wide, for engineering services (water, sewer, electricity and storm water) (hereinafter referred to as "the services"), in favour of the Section 21 Company, along any two boundaries, except a street boundary and, in the case of a panhandle erf, an additional servitude for services purposes, 2 m wide, over the entrance portion of the erf if and when required by the local authority: Provided that the Section 21 Company may waive any such servitude.
- (ii) No buildings or other structures may be erected within the aforesaid servitude area and no trees with large roots may be planted within the area of such servitude or within a distance of 2 m from it.
- (iii) The Section 21 Company shall be entitled to temporarily deposit on the land adjoining the aforesaid servitude, any material it excavates during the laying, maintenance or removal of such services and other works which in its discretion it regards necessary, and furthermore the Section 21 Company shall be entitled to reasonable access to the said property for the aforesaid purpose, subject to the provision that the Section 21 Company shall make good any damage caused during the laying, maintenance or removal of such services and other works

1.12 RESTRICTION ON THE ALIENATION OF LAND

Regardless of the issuing of a certificate as contemplated in section 82(1)(b)(ii)(cc) of the Town-planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance 15 of 1986), no erf in the township may be transferred or be dealt with otherwise until the City of Tshwane certifies that the developer has complied with the provisions of conditions 1.11.1 to 1.11.8 above.

2. CONDITIONS OF TITLE

2.1 THE ERVEN MENTIONED BELOW SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE CONDITION AS INDICATED, LAID DOWN BY THE CITY OF TSHWANE IN TERMS OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE TOWN-PLANNING AND TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1986 (ORDINANCE 15 OF 1986).

2.1.1 ALL ERVEN WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE ERF 748

- 2.1.1.1 The erf shall be subject to a servitude, 2m wide, for municipal services (water, sewer, electricity and storm-water) (hereinafter referred to as "the services"), in favour of the City of Tshwane, along any two boundaries, excepting a street boundary and, in the case of a panhandle erf, an additional servitude for municipal purposes, 2m wide, over the entrance portion of the erf, if and when required by the local authority: Provided that the local authority may waive any such servitude.
- 2.1.1.2 No buildings or other structures may be erected within the aforesaid servitude area and no trees with large roots may be planted within the area of such servitude or within a distance of 2 m from it.
- 2.1.1.3 The City of Tshwane shall be entitled to temporarily deposit on the land adjoining the aforesaid servitude, any material it excavates during the laying, maintenance or removal of such services and other works which in its discretion it regards necessary, and furthermore the Municipality shall be entitled to reasonable access to the said property for the aforesaid purpose, subject to the provision that the Municipality shall make good any damage caused during the laying, maintenance or removal of such services and other works.

2.1.2 ERF 748

The erf shall be subject to a servitude for access and municipal engineering services (water, sewerage, electricity) in favour of the City of Tshwane.
