GAUTENG PROVINCE**PROCLAMATION
by
THE PREMIER****TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS WITH EFFECT FROM 01 APRIL 2012 IN
TERMS OF SECTION 137 OF THE CONSTITUTION, 1996**

In terms of section 137(b) of the Constitution, I hereby transfer with effect from 01 April 2012 the administration of legislation and the powers and functions relating to:

- a) social development from the MEC for Health and Social Development to the MEC for Agriculture and Rural Development; and
- b) the creative industries and the Gauteng Film Commission from the MEC for Economic Development to the MEC for Sport, Arts, Culture and Recreation.

From the effective date the portfolios of the MEC Health and Social Development and the MEC Agriculture and Rural Development will respectively change to MEC Health and MEC Agriculture, Rural and Social Development.

Any reference to an MEC, excluding a reference to the MEC responsible for Finance, in any legislation regarding the functions transferred must be interpreted as a reference to the respective MEC's to whom the functions are transferred.
