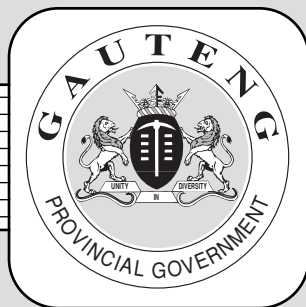

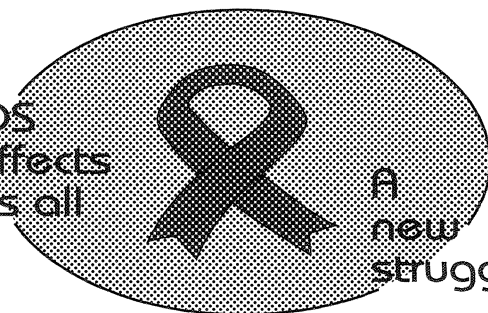

Tariffs exclude Value Added Tax . The moderate increase in landfill use tariffs is aimed at encouraging customers including local residents to make use of the facility and this is expected to reduce costs incurred in respect of the clearing and removal of illegal dumping.
