PROPOSED DETERMINATION OF A TSHWANE RAPID TRANSIT (A RE YENG) BUS FEEDER NETWORK ROUTE AND THE A RE YENG FEEDER BUS STOPS FOR THE PRETORIA CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT (CBD) AND HATFIELD STATION

Notice is hereby given, in terms of section 65bis (2) of the Local Government Ordinance 17 of 1939, read with sections 21 and 21A of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000 that the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality intends to:

- Determine four proposed feeder routes and stopping places to be added to the A Re Yeng feeder route network from the Central Business District (CBD) to Hatfield, covering the areas of Muckleneuk/Groenkloof, Pretoria CBD, and Sunnyside;
- Determine approximately 44 feeder bus stops along the route as indicated below:

Muckleneuk

Forward Route: Starts from Mahatma Gandhi Station, situated in Kotze Street at Bourke Street intersection, and proceed westerly to Troye Street and turn left into Troye Street. Proceed with Troye Street up to Justice Mahomed Street and turn right into Justice Mahomed Street. Proceed and turn left into Mears Street, continue southwards into Elandspoort Street proceed and turn left into Ridge Street and then turn right into Mears Street. Proceed with Mears Street and turn left into Willem Punt Avenue, proceed with Willem Punt Avenue up to the T-junction with Leyds Street and turn right into Leyds Street and proceed up to the terminus at the main entrance to the University of Pretoria, Groenkloof Campus.

Return route: Depart from the terminus in Leyds Street at the main entrance next to the University of Pretoria, Groenkloof Campus, continue and turn left into George Storrar Drive, proceed and turn left into Totius Street, proceed with Totius Street and turn left into Florence Ribeiro Avenue. Proceed with Florence Ribeiro Avenue and turn left into Sibelius Street, continue with Sibelius Street up to the T-junction with Leyds Street and turn right into Leyds Street, proceed and turn right into Bourke Street and continue in a northerly direction. Proceed with Bourke Street and turn left into Kotze Street towards Mahatma Gandhi Station.

Stop 1 - On Troye Street between Jorissen and Rissik Streets

Stop 2 - On Troye Street between Rissik and Justice Mahomed Streets

Stop 3 - On Steve Biko Street between Justice Mahomed and Ridge Streets

Stop 4 - On Elandspoort Street between Justice Mahomed and Ridge Streets

Stop 5 - On Willem Punt Avenue between Mears and Leyds Street

Stop 6 - On Leyds Street between George Storrar and Sibelius Street

Stop 7 - On Totius Street between Dr. Lategan and Steger Street

Stop 8 - On Florence Ribeiro Avenue between Totius and Sibelius Street

Stop 9 - On Sibelius Street between Lingbeek and Dr Lategan Street

Stop 10 - On Leyds Street between Sibelius and Preller Street

Stop 11 - On Bourke Street between Ridge and Berea Street

Pretoria CBD/Steve Biko Academic Hospital feeder

Forward Route: Starts from Nana Sita Station, situated in Nana Sita Street, in a westerly direction and turn right into Bosman Street and proceed and turn right into Boom Street. Proceed along Boom

Street bearing left and proceed into Soutpansberg Road, proceed bearing left into Dr. Savage Road. Continue along Dr. Savage Road and turn left into HF Verwoerd Road, proceed and take second off ramp under Bophelo Road and continue to the terminus in Malan Street.

Return route: Depart from terminus in Malan Street and proceed east and turn right into Johan Heyns Drive, proceed bearing right and turn right into Soutpansberg Road. Proceed along Soutpansberg Road bearing left into Dr. Savage Road, continue with Dr. Savage Road and turn left into Sisulu Street. Proceed with Sisulu Street and turn left into Struben Street, continue with Struben Street and turn right into Nelson Mandela Drive. Proceed with Nelson Mandela Drive and turn right into Nana Sita Street up to Nana Sita Bus Station

Stop 1 - On Bosman Street between Nana Sita and Francis Baard

Stop 2 - On Bosman Street between Pretorius and Stanza Bopape Street

Stop 3 - On Bosman Street between Madiba and Johannes Ramokhoase Street

Stop 4 - On Bosman Street between Struben Street and Bloed Street

Stop 5 - On Boom Street between Paul Kruger and Thabo Sehume Streets

Stop 6 - On Boom Street between Lilian Ngoyi and Sisulu Street

Stop 7 - On Dr Savage Road between Soutpansberg Road and Steve Biko Street

Stop 8 - On HF Verwoerd Road between Dr Savage Road and Malan Street

Stop 9 - On Malan Street between Dr Savage Road and Johan Heyns Streets

Stop 10 - Johan Heyns Drive between Rose and Annie Botha Street

Stop 11 - On Soutpansberg Road between Hamilton Street and Steve Biko Street

Stop 12 - On Soutpansberg Road between Steve Biko Street and Theodore Hove Avenue

Stop 13 - On Sisulu Street between Bloed Street and Struben Street

Stop 14 - On Struben Street between Sisulu Street and Du Toit Street

Stop 15 - Nelson Mandela Drive between Madiba Street and Stanza Bopape

Pretoria CBD Clockwise feeder

Route: Starts from Central Station and proceed in a westerly direction, turning right into Bosman Street, proceed and turn right into Madiba Street, proceed and turn right into Du Toit Street, proceed and turn right into Pretorius Street, proceed and turn left into Sisulu Street, proceed and turn right into Nana Sita Street and proceed up to Central Station.

Stop 1 - On Bosman Street between Nana Sita Street and Francis Baard Streets.

Stop 2 - On Bosman Street between Pretorius Street and WF Nkomo Street.

Stop 3 - On Madiba Street between Bosman Street and Paul Kruger Street

Stop 4 - On Madiba Street between Paul Kruger and Thabo Sehume Street

Stop 5 - On Madiba Street between Lilian Ngoyi Street and Sisulu Street

Stop 6 - On Du Toit Street between Stanza Bopape Street and Pretorius Streets

Stop 7 - On Pretorius Street between Du Toit and Sisulu Streets

Stop 8 - On Sisulu Street between Pretorius and Francis Baard Street.

Pretoria CBD anticlockwise feeder

Route: Starts from Central Station and proceed in an easterly direction on Nana Sita Street to Nana Sita Station, proceed on Nana Sita Street turning left into du Toit Street, proceed and turn left into Johannes Ramokhoase Street, proceed and turn left into Sophie de Bruyn Street, proceed and turn left into Nana Sita Street and proceed up to Central Station.

Stop 1 - On Du Toit Street between Francis Baard and Pretorius Streets.

Stop 2 - On Du Toit Street between Pretorius and Stanza Bopape Street

- Stop 3** - On Du Toit Street between Stanza Bopape and Madiba Street
