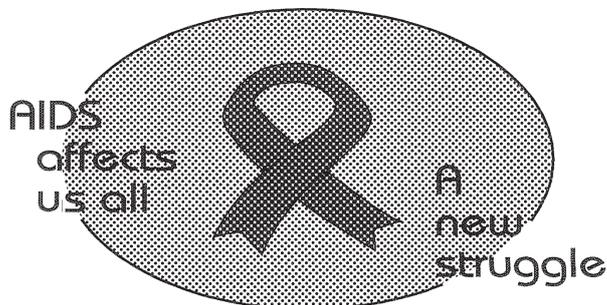

LOCAL AUTHORITY NOTICE 1878 OF 2016**GRAND CENTRAL EXTENSION/UITBREIDING 17**

- A. In terms of section 103 of the Town Planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance 15 of 1986), the City of Johannesburg Metropolitan Municipality declares **Grand Central Extension 17** to be an approved township, subject to the conditions set out in the Schedule hereunder.

SCHEDULE

STATEMENT OF THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE APPLICATION MADE BY MIDRAND TOWN CENTRE (PROPRIETARY) LIMITED (REGISTRATION NUMBER 790/06612/07) (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE TOWNSHIP OWNER) UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER III OF THE TOWN-PLANNING AND TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1986 (ORDINANCE 15 OF 1986), FOR PERMISSION TO ESTABLISH A TOWNSHIP ON PORTION 522 (A PORTION OF PORTION 448) OF THE FARM WATERVAL 5 I.R., PROVINCE OF GAUTENG, HAS BEEN APPROVED.

1. CONDITIONS OF ESTABLISHMENT.**(1) NAME**

The name of the township is **Grand Central Extension 17**.

(2) DESIGN

The township consists of erven and thoroughfares as indicated on General Plan S.G. No.3483/1997.

(3) DESIGN AND PROVISION OF ENGINEERING SERVICES IN AND FOR THE TOWNSHIP

(a) The township owner shall, to the satisfaction of the local authority, make the necessary arrangements for the design and provision of all engineering services of which the local authority is the supplier.

(b) The township owner shall not install or construct any engineering services unless the necessary written agreement has been entered into with the local authority, after proclamation of the township.

(c) Failure by the township owner to enter into the agreement contemplated in (b) above, shall result in the forfeiture of the off-setting of external contributions payable and any claims against the local authority, resulting from the installation of the bulk infrastructure.

(4) GAUTENG PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT (DEPARTMENT OF ROADS AND TRANSPORT)

(a) The application to establish the township, shall be resubmitted to the Department of Roads and Transport for reconsideration for the purpose of fulfillment of the requirements of the controlling authority in terms of the provisions of Section 48 of the Gauteng Transport Infrastructure Act, 2001 (Act 8 of 2001), when requested thereto by the local authority and/or the Department.

(b) The township owner shall, before or during development of the township, erect a physical barrier which is in compliance with the requirements of the said Department along Provincial Road K-101. The erection of such physical barrier and the maintenance thereof, shall be done to the satisfaction of the said Department.

(c) The township owner shall comply with the all conditions laid down by of the Department in terms of (a) above.

(5) NATIONAL GOVERNMENT (DEPARTMENT: MINERAL RESOURCES)

(a) The application to establish the township, shall be resubmitted to the Department: Mineral Resources for reconsideration, when requested thereto by the local authority and/or the Department.

(b) The township owner shall comply with the conditions laid down by of the Department in terms of (a) above.

(6) ACCESS

(a) Access to or egress from the township shall be provided to the satisfaction of the local authority and/or Johannesburg Roads Agency (Pty) Ltd and/or the Department of Roads and Transport (Gauteng Provincial Government).

(b) No access to or egress from the township shall be permitted along Provincial Road K-101.

(7) ACCEPTANCE AND DISPOSAL OF STORMWATER DRAINAGE

The township owner shall arrange for the stormwater drainage of the township to fit in with that of the adjacent roads and all stormwater running off or being diverted from the roads shall be received and disposed of.

(8) REFUSE REMOVAL

The township owner shall provide sufficient refuse collection points in the township and shall make arrangements to the satisfaction of the local authority for the removal of all refuse.

(9) REMOVAL OR REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING SERVICES

If, by reason of the establishment of the township, it should be necessary to remove or replace any existing municipal, TELKOM and/or ESKOM services, the cost of such removal or replacement shall be borne by the township owner.

(10) DEMOLITION OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES

The township owner shall at its own costs cause all existing buildings and structures situated within the building line reserves, side spaces or over common boundaries to be demolished to the satisfaction of the local authority, when requested thereto by the local authority.

(11) ENDOWMENT

The township owner shall, in terms of the provisions of Section 98(2) and Regulation 44 of the Town Planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance 15 of 1986), pay a lump sum as endowment to the local authority for the provision of land for a park (public open space).

(12) OBLIGATIONS WITH REGARD TO THE CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF ENGINEERING SERVICES AND RESTRICTIONS REGARDING THE ALIENATION OR TRANSFER OF ERVEN

(a) The township owner shall, after compliance with clause 1.(3) above, at its own costs and to the satisfaction of the local authority, construct and install all engineering services including the internal roads and the stormwater reticulation, within the boundaries of the township. Erven and/or units in the township, may not be alienated or transferred into the name of a purchaser nor shall a Certificate of Registered Title be registered, prior to the local authority certifying to the Registrar of Deeds that these engineering services had been constructed and installed.

(b) The township owner shall fulfil its obligations in respect of the installation of electricity, water and sanitary services as well as the construction of roads and stormwater drainage and the installation of systems therefor, as agreed between the township owner and the local authority in terms of clause 1.(3) above. Erven and/or units in the township, may not be alienated or transferred into the name of a purchaser nor shall a Certificate of Registered Title be registered, prior to the local authority certifying to the Registrar of Deeds that sufficient guarantees/cash contributions in respect of the engineering services have been submitted or paid to the said local authority.

(13) **OBLIGATIONS WITH REGARD TO THE PROTECTION OF ENGINEERING SERVICES**
The township owner shall, at its costs and to the satisfaction of the local authority, survey and register all servitudes required to protect the constructed/installed services. Erven and/or units in the township, may not be alienated or transferred into the name of a purchaser nor shall a Certificate of Registered Title be registered, prior to the local authority certifying to the Registrar of Deeds that these engineering services had been or will be protected to the satisfaction of the local authority.

2. DISPOSAL OF EXISTING CONDITIONS OF TITLE.

All erven shall be made subject to existing conditions and servitudes, if any:-

- (a) **Including the following servitude which does affect the township and shall be made applicable to all the erven in the township:**
- (i) *The erf is subject to a servitude, 2m wide, in favour of the local authority, for sewerage and other municipal purposes, along any two boundaries other than a street boundary and in the case of a panhandle erf, an additional servitude for municipal purposes 2m wide across the access portion of the erf, if and when required by the local authority: Provided that the local authority may dispense with any such servitude.*
 - (ii) *No building or other structure shall be erected within the aforesaid servitude area and no large rooted trees shall be planted within the area of such servitude or within 2m thereof.*
 - (iii) *The local authority shall be entitled to deposit temporarily on the land adjoining the aforesaid servitude such material as may be excavated by it during the process of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works as it, in its discretion may deem necessary and shall further be entitled to reasonable access to the said land for the aforesaid purpose subject to any damage done during the process of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works being made good by the local authority.*

3. CONDITIONS OF TITLE.

A. Conditions of Title imposed by the local authority in terms of the provisions of the Town-planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance 15 of 1986).

(1) ALL ERVEN

The erven lie in an area where soil conditions can affect and damage buildings and structures. Building plans submitted to the local authority for consideration shall indicate measures to be taken, to limit possible damage to buildings and structures as a result of detrimental foundation conditions. These measures shall be in accordance with the recommendation contained in the Geo-technical report for the township, unless it is proved to the local authority that such measures are unnecessary or that the same purpose can be achieved by other more effective means.

B. Conditions of Title imposed by the Department of Roads and Transport (Gauteng Provincial Government) in terms of the Gauteng Transport Infrastructure Act, 2001 (Act 8 of 2001), as amended.

(1) ERF 66

(a) The registered owner of the erf shall maintain, to the satisfaction of the Department of Roads and Transport (Gauteng Provincial Government), the physical barrier erected along the erf boundary abutting Road K-101.

(b) Except for the physical barrier referred to in clause (a) above, or any essential stormwater drainage structure, no building, structure or other thing which is attached to the land, even though it does not form part of that land, shall be erected neither shall anything be constructed or laid under or below the surface of the erf within a distance less than 16m from the erf boundary abutting Road K-101 neither shall any alteration or addition to any existing structure or building situated within such distance of the said boundary be made, except with the written consent of the Department of Roads and Transport (Gauteng Provincial Government).

B. The City of Johannesburg Metropolitan Municipality herewith in terms of the provisions of section 125(1)(a) of the Town Planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance 15 of 1986), declares that an amendment scheme, being an amendment of the Halfway House and Clayville Town Planning Scheme, 1976, comprising the same land as included in the township **Grand Central Extension 17**, has been approved. Map 3 and the scheme clauses of the amendment schemes are filed with the Executive Director: Development Planning: City of Johannesburg and are open for inspection at all reasonable times. This amendment is known as Amendment Scheme 1086.

VERKLARING VAN DIE VOORWAARDES WAAROP DIE AANSOEK GEDOEN DEUR MIDRAND TOWN CENTRE (EIENDOMS) BEPERK (REGISTRASIENOMMER 790/06612/07) (HIERNA DIE DORPSEIENAAR GENOEM) INGEVOLGE DIE BEPALINGS VAN HOOFSTUK III VAN DIE ORDONNANSIE OP DORPSBEPLANNING EN DORPE, 1986 (ORDONNANSIE 15 VAN 1986), OM TOESTEMMING OM 'N DORP TE STIG OP GEDEELTE 522 ('N GEDEELTE VAN GEDEELTE 448) VAN DIE PLAAS WATERVAL 5 I.R., PROVINISIE VAN GAUTENG, GOEDGEKEUR IS.

1. STIGTINGSVOORWAARDES**(1) NAAM**

Die naam van die dorp is **Grand Central Uitbreiding 17**.

(2) ONTWERP

Die dorp bestaan uit erwe en die deurpaaie soos aangedui op Algemene Plan LG Nr 3483/1997.

(3) ONTWERP EN VOORSIENING VAN INGENIEURSDIENSTE IN EN VIR DIE DORP

(a) Die dorpseienaar moet tot die tevredenheid van die plaaslike bestuur, die nodige reëlings tref vir die ontwerp en voorsiening van alle ingenieursdienste waarvan die plaaslike bestuur die verskaffer is.

(b) Die dorpseienaar mag geen ingenieursdienste installeer of oprig, tensy die nodige skriftelike ooreenkoms na proklamasie van die dorp, met die plaaslike bestuur gesluit is nie.

(c) Versuim deur die dorpseienaar om die ooreenkoms soos beoog in (b) hierbo aan te gaan, sal lei tot die verbeuring van die verrekening van eksterne grootmaatbydraes betaalbaar en enige eis teen die plaaslike bestuur, voortspruitend uit die installering van die grootmaatinfrastruktuur.

(4) GAUTENG PROVINSIALE REGERING (DEPARTEMENT VAN PAAIE EN VERVOER)

(a) Die aansoek om die dorp te stig, moet heringedien word by die Departement van Paaie en Vervoer vir heroorweging, vir doeleindes van die nakoming van die vereistes van die beherende liggaam in gevolge die bepalings van Artikel 48 van die Gauteng Vervoerinfrastruktuur Wet, 2001 (Wet 8 van 2001), wanneer daartoe versoek deur die plaaslike bestuur en/or die Departement.

(b) Die dorpseienaar moet voor of tydens ontwikkeling van die dorp, 'n fisiese versperring wat in ooreenstemming is met die vereistes van die gemelde Departement, langs Provinsiale Pad K-101 oprig. Die oprigting van sodanige versperring en die instandhouding daarvan, moet tot tevredenheid van die gemelde Departement gedoen word.

(c) Die dorpseienaar moet voldoen aan alle voorwaardes neergelê deur die Departement ingevolge (a) hierbo.

(5) NASIONALE REGERING (DEPARTEMENT: MINERALE HULPBRONNE)

(a) Die aansoek om die dorp te stig, moet heringedien word by die Departement: Minerale Hulpbronne vir heroorweging, wanneer daartoe versoek deur die plaaslike bestuur en/of die Departement.

(b) Die dorpseienaar moet voldoen aan alle voorwaardes neergelê deur die Departement ingevolge (a) hierbo.

(6) TOEGANG

(a) Toegang tot of uitgang vanuit die dorp moet voorsien word tot die tevredenheid van die plaaslike bestuur en/of Johannesburg Paaie Agentskap (Edms) Bpk en/of die Departement van Paaie en Vervoer (Gauteng Provinsiale Regering).

(b) Geen toegang tot of uitgang vanuit die dorp sal toegelaat word langs Provinsiale Pad K-101.

(7) ONTVANGS EN VERSORGING VAN STORMWATERDREINERING

Die dorpseienaar moet reël dat die stormwaterdreinering van die dorp inpas by dië van die aangrensende paaie en dat alle stormwater wat van die paaie afloop of afgelei word, ontvang en versorg word.

(8) VULLISVERWYDERING

Die dorpseienaar moet voldoende vullisversamelingspunte in die dorp voorsien en moet reëlings tot tevredenheid van die plaaslike bestuur tref vir die verwydering van alle vullis.

(9) VERWYDERING OF VERVANGING VAN BESTAANDE DIENSTE

Indien dit, as gevolg van die stigting van die dorp, nodig is om enige bestaande munisipale, TELKOM en/of ESKOM dienste te verwyder of te vervang, moet die koste van sodanige verwydering of vervanging deur die dorpseienaar gedra word.

(10) SLOPING VAN GEBOUE EN STRUKTURE

Die dorpseienaar moet op sy eie koste, alle bestaande geboue en strukture wat binne boulynreserwes, kantruimtes of oor gemeenskaplike grense geleë is, laat sloop tot die tevredenheid van die plaaslike bestuur, wanneer daartoe versoek deur die plaaslike bestuur.

(11) BEGIFTIGING

Die dorpseienaar moet ingevolge die bepalings van Artikel 98(2) saamgelees met Regulasie 44 van die Dorpsbeplanning en Dorpe Ordonnansie, 1986 (Ordonnansie 15 van 1986) 'n globale bedrag as begiftiging aan die plaaslike bestuur betaal vir die voorsiening van grond vir 'n park (openbare oop ruimte).

(12) VERPLIGTINGE TEN OPSIGTE VAN DIE KONSTRUKSIE EN INSTALLASIE VAN INGENIEURSDIENSTE EN BEPERKINGS BETREFFENDE DIE VERVREEMDING OF OORDRAG VAN ERWE

(a) Die dorpseienaar moet na voldoening aan klousule 1.(3) hierbo op sy eie koste en tot tevredenheid van die plaaslike bestuur, alle ingenieursdienste binne die grense van die dorp, oprig en installeer, insluitend die interne paaie en die stormwaterretikulasie. Erwe en/of eenhede in die dorp mag nie vervreem of oorgedra word in die naam van 'n koper, ook mag 'n Sertifikaat van Geregistreerde Titel nie geregistreer word nie, alvorens die plaaslike bestuur aan die Registrateur van Aktes gesertifiseer het dat hierdie ingenieursdienste opgerig en geïnstalleer is.

(b) Die dorpseienaar moet sy verpligtinge met betrekking tot die installering van elektrisiteit, water en sanitêre dienste asook die konstruksie van paaie en stormwaterdreinerings en die installering van die stelsels daarvoor, nakom soos ooreengekom tussen die dorpseienaar en die plaaslike bestuur ingevolge klousule 1.(3) hierbo. Erwe en/of eenhede in die dorp mag nie vervreem of oorgedra word in die naam van 'n koper, ook mag 'n Sertifikaat van Geregistreerde Titel nie geregistreer word nie, alvorens die plaaslike bestuur aan die Registrateur van Aktes gesertifiseer het dat voldoende waarborge/kontantbydraes ten opsigte van die ingenieursdienste, aan die plaaslike bestuur gelewer of betaal is.

(13) VERPLIGTINGE MET BETREKKING TOT DIE BESKERMING VAN INGENIEURSDIENSTE
Die dorpseienaar moet op sy eie koste en tot tevredeheid van die plaaslike bestuur, alle servitute opmeet en registreer om die geboude en/of geïnstalleerde dienste te beskerm. Erwe en/of eenhede in die dorp, mag nie vervreem of oorgedra word in die naam van 'n koper, ook mag 'n Sertifikaat van Geregistreerde Titel geregistreer word nie, alvorens die plaaslike bestuur aan die Registrateur van Aktes gesertifiseer het dat hierdie ingenieursdienste tot tevredeheid van die plaaslike bestuur, beskerm is of sal word.

2. BESKIKKING OOR BESTAANDE TITELVOORWAARDES

Hierdie maatreëls moet in ooreenstemming wees met die aanbeveling vervat in die Geotegniese verslag van die dorp, tensy bewys kan word dat sodanige maatreëls onnodig is of dat dieselfde doel op ander meer effektiewe wyse bereik kan word.

B. Titelvoorwaardes opgelê deur die Departement van Paaie en Vervoer (Gauteng Provinsiale Regering) ingevolge die bepalings van die Gauteng Vervoerinfrastruktuur Wet, 2001 (Wet 8 van 2001), soos gewysig.

(1) ERF 66

(a) Die geregistreerde eienaar van die erf, moet die fisiese versperring wat langs die erfrens aangrensend aan Pad K-101 opgerig is, tot tevredenheid van die Departement van Paaie en Vervoer (Gauteng Provinsiale Regering) instandhou.

(b) Behalwe vir die fisiese versperring waarna in klousule (a) hierbo verwys word of enige noodsaaklike stormwaterdreineringsstruktuur, mag geen gebou, struktuur of ander ding wat aan die grond geheg is, selfs al vorm dit nie deel van die grond nie, opgerig word nie of sal niks gebou word op of gelê word binne of onder die oppervlakte van die erwe binne 'n afstand van minder as 16m vanaf die erfrens aangrensend aan Pad K-101. Geen verandering of aanbouing mag aan enige bestaande struktuur of gebou geleë binne die vermelde afstand gedoen word nie, behalwe met die skriftelike toestemming van die Departement van Paaie en Vervoer (Gauteng Provinsiale Regering).

(3) DESIGN AND PROVISION OF ENGINEERING SERVICES IN AND FOR THE TOWNSHIP

(a) The township owner shall, to the satisfaction of the local authority, make the necessary arrangements for the design and provision of all engineering services of which the local authority is the supplier.

(b) The township owner shall not install or construct any engineering services unless the necessary written agreement has been entered into with the local authority, after proclamation of the township.

(c) Failure by the township owner to enter into the agreement contemplated in (b) above, shall result in the forfeiture of the off-setting of external contributions payable and any claims against the local authority, resulting from the installation of the bulk infrastructure.

(4) GAUTENG PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT (DEPARTMENT OF ROADS AND TRANSPORT)

The application to establish the township, shall be resubmitted to the Department of Roads and Transport for reconsideration for the purpose of fulfillment of the requirements of the controlling authority in terms of the provisions of Section 48 of the Gauteng Transport Infrastructure Act, 2001 (Act 8 of 2001), when requested thereto by the local authority and/or the Department.

(5) NATIONAL GOVERNMENT (DEPARTMENT: MINERAL RESOURCES)

(a) The application to establish the township, shall be resubmitted to the Department: Mineral Resources for reconsideration, when requested thereto by the local authority and/or the Department.

(b) The township owner shall comply with the conditions laid down by of the Department in terms of (a) above.

(6) ACCESS

Access to or egress from the township shall be provided to the satisfaction of the local authority and/or Johannesburg Roads Agency (Pty) Ltd.

(7) ACCEPTANCE AND DISPOSAL OF STORMWATER DRAINAGE

The township owner shall arrange for the stormwater drainage of the township to fit in with that of the adjacent roads and all stormwater running off or being diverted from the roads shall be received and disposed of.

(8) REFUSE REMOVAL

The township owner shall provide sufficient refuse collection points in the township and shall make arrangements to the satisfaction of the local authority for the removal of all refuse.

(9) REMOVAL OR REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING SERVICES

If, by reason of the establishment of the township, it should be necessary to remove or replace any existing municipal, TELKOM and/or ESKOM services, the cost of such removal or replacement shall be borne by the township owner.

(10) DEMOLITION OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES

The township owner shall at its own costs cause all existing buildings and structures situated within the building line reserves, side spaces or over common boundaries to be demolished to the satisfaction of the local authority, when requested thereto by the local authority.

(11) ENDOWMENT

The township owner shall, in terms of the provisions of Section 98(2) and Regulation 44 of the Town Planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance 15 of 1986), pay a lump sum as endowment to the local authority for the provision of land for a park (public open space).

(12) OBLIGATIONS WITH REGARD TO THE CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF ENGINEERING SERVICES AND RESTRICTIONS REGARDING THE ALIENATION OR TRANSFER OF ERVEN

(a) The township owner shall, after compliance with clause 1.(3) above, at its own costs and to the satisfaction of the local authority, construct and install all engineering services including the internal roads and the stormwater reticulation, within the boundaries of the township. Erven and/or units in the township, may not be alienated or transferred into the name of a purchaser nor shall a Certificate of Registered Title be registered, prior to the local authority certifying to the Registrar of Deeds that these engineering services had been constructed and installed.

(b) The township owner shall fulfil its obligations in respect of the installation of electricity, water and sanitary services as well as the construction of roads and stormwater drainage and the installation of systems therefor, as agreed between the township owner and the local authority in terms of clause 1.(3) above. Erven and/or units in the township, may not be alienated or transferred into the name of a purchaser nor shall a Certificate of Registered Title be registered, prior to the local authority certifying to the Registrar of Deeds that sufficient guarantees/cash contributions in respect of the engineering services have been submitted or paid to the said local authority.

(13) OBLIGATIONS WITH REGARD TO THE PROTECTION OF ENGINEERING SERVICES

The township owner shall, at its costs and to the satisfaction of the local authority, survey and register all servitudes required to protect the constructed/installed services. Erven and/or units in the township, may not be alienated or transferred into the name of a purchaser nor shall a Certificate of Registered Title be registered, prior to the local authority certifying to the Registrar of Deeds that these engineering services had been or will be protected to the satisfaction of the local authority.

2. DISPOSAL OF EXISTING CONDITIONS OF TITLE.

All erven shall be made subject to existing conditions and servitudes, if any:-

- (a) **Including the following servitude which does affect the township and shall be made applicable to all the erven in the township:**
- (i) *The erf is subject to a servitude, 2m wide, in favour of the local authority, for sewerage and other municipal purposes, along any two boundaries other than a street boundary and in the case of a panhandle erf, an additional servitude for municipal purposes 2m wide across the access portion of the erf, if and when required by the local authority: Provided that the local authority may dispense with any such servitude.*
- (ii) *No building or other structure shall be erected within the aforesaid servitude area and no large rooted trees shall be planted within the area of such servitude or within 2m thereof.*
- (iii) *The local authority shall be entitled to deposit temporarily on the land adjoining the aforesaid servitude such material as may be excavated by it during the process of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works as it, in its discretion may deem necessary and shall further be entitled to reasonable access to the said land for the aforesaid purpose subject to any damage done during the process of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works being made good by the local authority.*

3. CONDITIONS OF TITLE.

A. Conditions of Title imposed by the local authority in terms of the provisions of the Town-planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance 15 of 1986).

(1) ALL ERVEN

The erven lie in an area where soil conditions can affect and damage buildings and structures. Building plans submitted to the local authority for consideration shall indicate measures to be taken, to limit possible damage to buildings and structures as a result of detrimental foundation conditions. These measures shall be in accordance with the recommendation contained in the Geo-technical report for the township, unless it is proved to the local authority that such measures are unnecessary or that the same purpose can be achieved by other more effective means.

- B. The City of Johannesburg Metropolitan Municipality herewith in terms of the provisions of section 125(1)(a) of the Town Planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance 15 of 1986), declares that an amendment scheme, being an amendment of the Halfway House and Clayville Town Planning Scheme, 1976, comprising the same land as included in the township **Grand Central Extension 16**, has been approved. Map 3 and the scheme clauses of the amendment schemes are filed with the Executive Director: Development Planning: City of Johannesburg and are open for inspection at all reasonable times. This amendment is known as Amendment Scheme 1085.

VERKLARING VAN DIE VOORWAARDES WAAROP DIE AANSOEK GEDOEN DEUR MIDRAND TOWN CENTRE (EIENDOMS) BEPERK (REGISTRASIENOMMER 790/06612/07) (HIERNA DIE DORPSEIENAAR GENOEM) INGEVOLGE DIE BEPALINGS VAN HOOFSTUK III VAN DIE ORDONNANSIE OP DORPSBEPLANNING EN DORPE, 1986 (ORDONNANSIE 15 VAN 1986), OM TOESTEMMING OM 'N DORP TE STIG OP GEDEELTE 521 ('N GEDEELTE VAN GEDEELTE 448) VAN DIE PLAAS WATERVAL 5 I.R., PROVINISIE VAN GAUTENG, GOEDGEKEUR IS.

1. STIGTINGSVOORWAARDES**(1) NAAM**

Die naam van die dorp is **Grand Central Uitbreiding 16**.

(2) ONTWERP

Die dorp bestaan uit erwe en die deurpaaie soos aangedui op Algemene Plan LG Nr 3482/1997.

(3) ONTWERP EN VOORSIENING VAN INGENIEURSDIENSTE IN EN VIR DIE DORP

(a) Die dorpseienaar moet tot die tevredenheid van die plaaslike bestuur, die nodige reëlings tref vir die ontwerp en voorsiening van alle ingenieursdienste waarvan die plaaslike bestuur die verskaffer is.

(b) Die dorpseienaar mag geen ingenieursdienste installeer of oprig, tensy die nodige skriftelike ooreenkoms na proklamasie van die dorp, met die plaaslike bestuur gesluit is nie.

(c) Versuim deur die dorpseienaar om die ooreenkoms soos beoog in (b) hierbo aan te gaan, sal lei tot die verbeuring van die verrekening van eksterne grootmaatbydraes betaalbaar en enige eis teen die plaaslike bestuur, voortspruitend uit die installering van die grootmaatinfrastruktuur.

(4) GAUTENG PROVINSIALE REGERING (DEPARTEMENT VAN PAAIE EN VERVOER)

Die aansoek om die dorp te stig, moet heringedien word by die Departement van Paaie en Vervoer vir heroorweging, vir doeleindes van die nakoming van die vereistes van die beherende liggaam in gevolge die bepalings van Artikel 48 van die Gauteng Vervoerinfrastruktuur Wet, 2001 (Wet 8 van 2001), wanneer daartoe versoek deur die plaaslike bestuur en/or die Departement.

(5) NASIONALE REGERING (DEPARTEMENT: MINERALE HULPBRONNE)

(a) Die aansoek om die dorp te stig, moet heringedien word by die Departement: Minerale Hulpbronne vir heroorweging, wanneer daartoe versoek deur die plaaslike bestuur en/of die Departement.

(b) Die dorpseienaar moet voldoen aan alle voorwaardes neergelê deur die Departement ingevolge (a) hierbo.

(6) TOEGANG

Toegang tot of uitgang vanuit die dorp moet voorsien word tot die tevredenheid van die plaaslike bestuur en/of Johannesburg Paaie Agentskap (Edms) Bpk.

(7) ONTVANGS EN VERSORGING VAN STORMWATERDREINERING

Die dorpseienaar moet reël dat die stormwaterdreinering van die dorp inpas by dië van die aangrensende paaie en dat alle stormwater wat van die paaie afloop of afgelei word, ontvang en versorg word.

(8) VULLISVERWYDERING

Die dorpseienaar moet voldoende vullisversamelingspunte in die dorp voorsien en moet reëlings tot tevredenheid van die plaaslike bestuur tref vir die verwydering van alle vullis.

(9) VERWYDERING OF VERVANGING VAN BESTAANDE DIENSTE

Indien dit, as gevolg van die stigting van die dorp, nodig is om enige bestaande munisipale, TELKOM en/of ESKOM dienste te verwyder of te vervang, moet die koste van sodanige verwydering of vervanging deur die dorpseienaar gedra word.

(10) SLOPING VAN GEBOUE EN STRUKTURE

Die dorpseienaar moet op sy eie koste, alle bestaande geboue en strukture wat binne boulynreserwes, kantruimtes of oor gemeenskaplike grense geleë is, laat sloop tot die tevredenheid van die plaaslike bestuur, wanneer daartoe versoek deur die plaaslike bestuur.

(11) BEGIFTIGING

Die dorpseienaar moet ingevolge die bepalings van Artikel 98(2) saamgelees met Regulasie 44 van die Dorpsbeplanning en Dorpe Ordonnansie, 1986 (Ordonnansie 15 van 1986) 'n globale bedrag as begiftiging aan die plaaslike bestuur betaal vir die voorsiening van grond vir 'n park (openbare oop ruimte).

(12) VERPLIGTINGE TEN OPSIGTE VAN DIE KONSTRUKSIE EN INSTALLASIE VAN INGENIEURSDIENSTE EN BEPERKINGS BETREFFENDE DIE VERVREEMDING OF OORDRAG VAN ERWE

(a) Die dorpseienaar moet na voldoening aan klousule 1.(3) hierbo op sy eie koste en tot tevredenheid van die plaaslike bestuur, alle ingenieursdienste binne die grense van die dorp, oprig en installeer, insluitend die interne paaie en die stormwaterretikulasie. Erwe en/of eenhede in die dorp mag nie vervreem of oorgedra word in die naam van 'n koper, ook mag 'n Sertifikaat van Geregistreerde Titel nie geregistreer word nie, alvorens die plaaslike bestuur aan die Registrateur van Aktes gesertifiseer het dat hierdie ingenieursdienste opgerig en geïnstalleer is.

(b) Die dorpseienaar moet sy verpligtinge met betrekking tot die installering van elektrisiteit, water en sanitêre dienste asook die konstruksie van paaie en stormwaterdreinering en die installering van die stelsels daarvoor, nakom soos ooreengekom tussen die dorpseienaar en die plaaslike bestuur ingevolge klousule 1.(3) hierbo. Erwe en/of eenhede in die dorp mag nie vervreem of oorgedra word in die naam van 'n koper, ook mag 'n Sertifikaat van Geregistreerde Titel nie geregistreer word nie, alvorens die plaaslike bestuur aan die Registrateur van Aktes gesertifiseer het dat voldoende waarborge/kontantbydraes ten opsigte van die ingenieursdienste, aan die plaaslike bestuur gelewer of betaal is.

(13) VERPLIGTINGE MET BETREKKING TOT DIE BESKERMING VAN INGENIEURSDIENSTE

Die dorpseienaar moet op sy eie koste en tot tevredenheid van die plaaslike bestuur, alle serwitute opmeet en registreer om die geboue en/of geïnstalleerde dienste te beskerm. Erwe en/of eenhede in die dorp, mag nie vervreem of oorgedra word in die naam van 'n koper, ook mag 'n Sertifikaat van Geregistreerde Titel geregistreer word nie, alvorens die plaaslike bestuur aan die Registrateur van Aktes gesertifiseer het dat hierdie ingenieursdienste tot tevredenheid van die plaaslike bestuur, beskerm is of sal word.

2. BESIKKING OOR BESTAANDE TITELVOORWAARDES

Alle erwe moet onderworpe gemaak word aan bestaande voorwaardes en serwitute, indien enige:-

A. Insluitend die volgende serwituut wat die dorp raak en wat van toepassing gemaak moet word op al die erwe in die dorp:

- (i) *The erf is subject to a servitude, 2m wide, in favour of the local authority, for sewerage and other municipal purposes, along any two boundaries other than a street boundary and in the case of a panhandle erf, an additional servitude for municipal purposes 2m wide across the access portion of the erf, if and when required by the local authority: Provided that the local authority may dispense with any such servitude.*
- (ii) *No building or other structure shall be erected within the aforesaid servitude area and no large rooted trees shall be planted within the area of such servitude or within 2m thereof.*
- (iii) *The local authority shall be entitled to deposit temporarily on the land adjoining the aforesaid servitude such material as may be excavated by it during the process of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works as it, in its discretion may deem necessary and shall further be entitled to reasonable access to the said land for the aforesaid purpose subject to any damage done during the process of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works being made good by the local authority.*

Hierdie maatreëls moet in ooreenstemming wees met die aanbeveling vervat in die Geotegniese verslag van die dorp, tensy bewys kan word dat sodanige maatreëls onnodig is of dat dieselfde doel op ander meer effektiewe wyse bereik kan word.

- D. Die Stad van Johannesburg Metropolitaanse Munisipaliteit verklaar hiermee ingevolge die bepalings van artikel 125(1)(a) van die Ordonnansie op Dorpsbeplanning en Dorpe, 1986 (Ordonnansie 15 van 1986), dat 'n wysigingskema, synde 'n wysiging van die Halfway House en Clayville Dorpsbeplanningskema, 1976 wat uit dieselfde grond as die dorp **Grand Central Uitbreiding 16** bestaan, goedgekeur is.
