

PROVINCIAL NOTICE 565 OF 2017

ACCEPTANCE AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AMENDED PRELIMINARY DESIGN OF PROVINCIAL ROAD K50 BETWEEN N1-21 (MATROOSBERG STREET) AND K69 (GEORGE EYNERS STREET): PRETORIA

In terms of section 8(6) and (7) of the Gauteng Transport Infrastructure Act, 2001 (Act No 8 of 2001) ("the Act") it is hereby notified for general information that the Member of the Executive Council for the Gauteng Province ("the MEC") for Roads and Transport has considered and accepted the amended Preliminary Design of provincial road K50 between N1-21 (Matroosberg street) and K69 (George Eyners street) for implementation. The acceptance concerns those sections of the provincial road published for public comments in the Provincial Gazette, Notice 98 and 99 of 14 February 2017.

It should further be noted that the regulatory measures provided for in section 7 of the Act in respect of the route cease to apply from the date of this notice to the extent of the route along or over which the preliminary design was accepted by the MEC in terms of the section 8(6) of the Act and that the regulatory measures contained in section 9 of the aforementioned Act apply with relation to the accepted preliminary design from the date of this notice.
