

The Dolomite Risk Management By-laws are intended to provide for:

- an integrated, standardised approach to spatial planning and land use management by the Johannesburg Metropolitan Municipality on dolomite land;
- an integrated Dolomite Risk Management System to reduce the likelihood of sinkholes and subsidences occurring;
- establishing a tolerable hazard rating on dolomite land in the Municipality and
- empowering officials in the Johannesburg Metropolitan Municipality to effectively assert law enforcement to ensure safe, sustainable development on dolomite land.
