GENERAL NOTICE

NOMINATIONS OF CANDIDATES FOR APPOINTMENT TO SERVE AS
MEMBERS OF GGT2030 TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE PANEL

1. Interested parties, persons, sectoral groups and other stakeholders are hereby invited to submit written nominations for the appointment of candidates to serve as members of the Technical Advisory Committee Panel established in accordance with regulation 20 of the Treasury Regulations issued in terms of section 76 of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999). The Panel shall provide project management support towards Growing Gauteng Together (GGT) 2030 on Implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the high-growth sectors and economic infrastructure programmes.

2. The Panel shall consist of no less than 12 and no more than 20 members and serve for a term of office not exceeding three years. Candidates must have full understanding of the GGT2030 and transversal skills, such as investor intelligence, investor mobilisation and investment design, and partnership structuring between public and private sector entities, including risk allocation, design thinking, rapid iteration and agile approaches with respect to programme design, monitoring and implementation, efficient and time-optimised coordination and reporting. In addition, members must have content expertise on the 10 high-growth sectors of the GGT2030, particularly green energy, digital economy, broadband rollout, global business services, transportation and logistics, construction, agro-processing and agri-supply ecosystems and cannabis industrialisation.

3. The following considerations shall apply in the selection of suitable candidates:
(a) knowledge and active involvement in one or more of the 10 high-growth sectors of the GGT2030 (b) knowledge and experience in the field of—(i) economic infrastructure development, e.g. Special Economic Zones, industrial parks or hubs (ii) Township Economy Revitalisation and Small Micro and Medium Enterprise development (iii) Programme and Project Management, Local

Production and Local Content frameworks and (c) proven business acumen, knowledge of the business development support programmes, including both financial and non-financial support.

4. A person may not be appointed as member of the Panel if that person—(a) is not a citizen of the Republic and is not resident in the Gauteng Province (b) is a member of Parliament, a Provincial Legislature, a Municipal Council or a House of Traditional Leaders established in terms of the Constitution (c) is an unrehabilitated insolvent (d) is of unsound mind as declared by a competent court (e) has at any time been removed from an office of trust on account of misconduct and (f) has previously been removed from any other committee for breach of committee rules.

5. A person may nominate herself or himself and complete nominations, including—(a) full names of the nominee (a) motivation for the nominee (c) certified copy of the nominee's identity document not older than six months (d) certified copies of the nominee's qualification(s) not older than six months (e) letter of consent from the nominee and (f) a comprehensive CV of the nominee, must be submitted Online or by Email ONLY to: TACPAdvent@gauteng.gov.za. Failure to complete or disclose all required information, including any disqualification in terms of paragraph 4, may disqualify a nominee or candidate. The successful candidate will be required to periodically declare her or his financial interests and conducting of any business with the State.
