DRAFT ORDER

Having considered the papers and having heard counsel - the following ORDER is issued:

1. The matter is postponed to 20 and 21 November 2020 for argument, and the rule *nisi* is extended to that date:

LA

- The first, thirteenth and fourteenth respondents and any other respondent which wishes to file an answering affidavit – shall file their answering affidavits by 12 October 2020;
- The applicant shall file replying affidavits in response to all answering affidavits to which it has not yet replied by 26 October 2020;
- 4. The applicant shall file heads of argument by 28 October 2020;
- 5. The respondents shall file heads of argument by 4 November 2020;
- 6. Costs are reserved.
- 7. For the purposes of clarification paragraph 2 of the order granted by the special tribunal the Honourable Justice Method on 20 August 2020, read together with schedule A thereto, requires freezing of amounts in the relevant bank accounts of the Respondents only to the extent of the amounts specified in schedule A or any portion thereof which was still available in those bank accounts at the time the order was granted (whichever is the lesser).
- 8. A pre-hearing meeting shall be held between the parties' legal teams via video conference to be arranged between the parties at which they will seek to agree on the sequence and time allocation for oral argument on the day of the hearing, being 20 and 21 November 2020. These arrangements shall be conveyed to the presiding Judge by no later than 13 November 2020. In the event of the failure by the parties to reach such an agreement, the arrangements will be made for the presiding Judge to chair a case management meeting prior to the hearing of the matter to determine these issues.

9. Costs are referred.
