DECLARATION OF A KWAZULU-NATAL PROVINCIAL STATE OF DISASTER

I, S Zikalala, in my capacity as Premier of the Province of KwaZulu-Natal, under powers vested in me by section 41(1)(b) of the Disaster Management Act, 2002 (Act No. 57 of 2002), and after consultation with all other members of the KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Executive Council, hereby, as a result of the damage caused by inclement weather and the subsequent damage and loss of life which occurred during the festive period of the summer season between **November 2019 and 31 January 2020**, declare a state of disaster in the Local Municipalities contemplated in Column 2 of the Schedule, falling within the area of jurisdiction of the District Municipalities contemplated in Column 1 of the Schedule.
