

PREMIER'S NOTICE

PROCLAMATION

BY THE

PREMIER OF THE NORTHERN PROVINCE

No. 1 (Premier's) 2000

DETERMINATION OF THE SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES OF MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCILS AND MEMBERS OF PROVINCIAL LEGISLATURE OF THE NORTHERN PROVINCE

- 1. In terms of Section 6 (3) (a) of the Remuneration of Public Office Bearers Act, 1998 (Act No. 20 of 1998) (hereafter referred to as "the Remuneration Act"), I hereby determine that the annual salaries and allowances of the various grades of Members of the Executive Council and Members of the Provincial Legislature mentioned in Column 1 of the Schedule shall be set out in column 2, 3 or 4 of the schedule with effect from 1 April 2000, subject to section 3(6)(a) and (b) of the Remuneration Act, are categorised under the grades specified in Column 1, to be as specified in Column 2 of that Schedule.
- Column 4 of the Schedule applies to a re-elected member who has occupied his or her current office, or an office in the same or a higher grade according to Column 1 of the Schedule, for a continuous period of at least 24 months in total whether before or after 2 June 1999.
- 3. Column 3 of the Schedule applies to all re-elected members other than those referred to in paragraph 2. When a re-elected member to whom Column 3 applies has held his or her current office, or an office in the same or a higher grade according to Column 1, for a continuous period of 24 months in total, Column 4 becomes applicable to that member.
- 4. Column 2 of the Schedule applies to all members of a Provincial Legislature who are not re-elected members.
- 5. For the purpose of calculating the period of 24 months referred to in paragraphs 2 and 3, a re-elected member is regarded to have continued to be a member of a Provincial Legislature during the period 2 June 1999, until the date on which he or she was designed as such a member pursuant to the elections of that date.
- 6. In terms of Section 6 (4) of the Remuneration Act, I determine the amount of R40 000 per annum as the portion of the remuneration of a Member of the Executive Council and a Member of the Provincial Legislature to which Section 8 (1) (d) of the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No.58 of 1962), shall apply.
- 7. Except for the salaries and allowances provided for in this Proclamation, the office-bearer mentioned in Column 1 of the Schedule are not entitled to any other remuneration, whether directly or indirectly, in respect of the offices held by them.

8. In this Proclamation, unless the context indicates otherwise, any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Remuneration Act, the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996, or the relevant Rules and Orders contemplated in section 116 of the Constitution, bears that meaning; and

"re-elected member" means a person who -

- (a) immediately before 2 June 1999 was a member of a Provincial Legislature; and
- (b) following the election of 2 June 2000, was designated as such a member by the Electoral Commission.
- Proclamation No. 10 of 1999, published in the Provincial Government Gazette of 24 November 1999, is hereby repealed.
