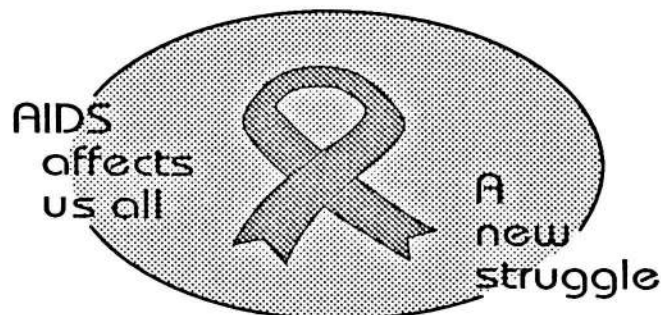

### NOTICE 33 OF 2003

#### ROAD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT CORPORATION

#### INVITATION BY THE SHAREHOLDERS COMMITTEE FOR NOMINATIONS OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT CORPORATION

The Shareholders Committee invites, in terms of section 8(10)(a) of the Road Traffic Management Corporation Act, 1999 (Act No. 20 of 1999), nominations for persons to be members of the Board for the Road Traffic Management Corporation.

The objectives of the Road Traffic Management Corporation are- (a) to establish a partnership between national, provincial and local spheres of government by effecting the pooling of road traffic powers of the Minister and every MEC and the resources of national and provincial spheres of government responsible for road traffic strategic planning, regulation, facilitation and law enforcement; strengthening national and provincial governments' collective capacity to govern road traffic through partnerships with local government bodies and the private sector; and focusing government on effective strategic planning, regulation, facilitation and monitoring; to enhance the overall quality of road traffic service provision and, in particular, to ensure safety, security, order, discipline and mobility on the roads; to phase out, where appropriate public funding and phase in private sector investment in road traffic on a competitive basis, to introduce commercial management principles to inform and guide road traffic governance and decision-making in the interest of enhanced service provision; to optimize the utilization of public funds by securing, where appropriate, full cost recovery on the basis of the user-pays principles.

The members of the Board must be persons from the public and private sectors with proven expertise and competency in the field of road traffic management, corporate management, commerce, commercial banking and financing.

The Board will enter into a governance agreement, in terms of section 9 of the Road Traffic Management Corporation Act, 1999, with the Shareholders Committee relating to the expectations of national, provincial and local governments in respect of the Corporation's scope of business, efficiency, financial performance and achievement of objectives.

Nominations with a brief motivation can be made both by organization and individuals. Nominations are to be accompanied by acceptance by the nominees. Nominees must be South African citizens.
