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

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PROCLAMATION

by the

Premier of the Limpopo Province

No. 6, 2004

DETERMINATION OF THE UPPER LIMIT OF THE SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES OF MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCILS AND MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THE LIMPOPO PROVINCE

- 1. In terms of Section 6(3) (a) of the Remuneration of Public Office Bearers Act, 1998 (Act No. 20 of 1998) ("the Remuneration Act"), I hereby determine that the upper limit of the annual salaries and allowances of the various grades of the office bearers mentioned in Column 1 of Schedule 1 and 2 shall be as set out in Columns 2, 3 and 4 of Schedule 1 with effect from 1 April 2004, subject to Section 6(7) (a) and (b) of the Remuneration Act.
- Column 4 of Schedule 1 (Notch 3) applies to a re-elected member who has
 occupied his or he office in the same or a higher grade according to Column 1, for
 a period of at least 24 months in total, whether before or after 14 April 2004.
- 3. Column 3 of Schedule 1 (Notch 2) applies to all re-elected members other than those referred to in paragraph 2. When a re-elected member to whom Column 3 applies has held his or her current office, or an office in the same or higher grade according to Column 1, for a period of 24 months in total, Column 4 becomes applicable to that member.
- Column 2 of the Schedule 1 (Notch 1) applies to all Members of the Provincial Legislature who are not re-elected members.
- 5. For the purpose of calculating the period of 24 months referred to in paragraphs 2 and 3, a re-elected member who –

- (a) was a member of Parliament or a Provincial Legislature on 13 April 2004,
 and
- (b) pursuant to the election of 14 April 2004 was, designated by the Electoral Commission as a member of the National Assembly or Provincial Legislature or appointed as a permanent delegate to the National Council of Provinces (NCOP) in terms of Section 61(2) (b) of the Constitution, is regarded to have continued to occupy the position occupied by him or her on 13 April 2004 until so designated or appointed.
- 6. In terms of Section 6(4) of the Remuneration Act, I determine the amount of R40 000 per annum as that portion of the remuneration of a member or office bearer of the Provincial Legislature to which Section 8(1) (d) of the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962), shall apply.
- 7. In this Notice -

"member of Parliament" means a member of the National Assembly or a permanent delegate to the National Council of Provinces or a member of the Legislature

"re-elected member" means a person -

- (i) who at any time before 14 April 2004 occupies an office mentioned in Column 1; and
- (ii) whose service in any one of those offices has not been interrupted at any time for a continuous period of more than 24 months.
- 8. Except for the salaries and allowances provided for in this Notice, the office bearers mentioned in Column 1 of Schedule 1 are not entitled to any other remuneration, whether directly or indirectly, in respect of the offices held by them.

9. Proclamation No. 2 of 2003 published in the Provincial Gazette No. 899 of 19 May 2003, is hereby repealed.
