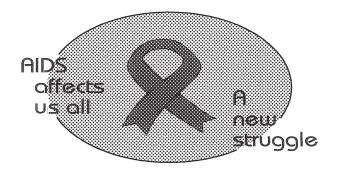

The New Kathu Cemetery will be approximately 5 hectares in extent on land owned by the Sishen Iron Ore Company. The land for the new cemetery will be transferred to the Gamagara Local Municipality through a land swap agreement as part of the Dingleton Resettlement project.
