





Northern Cape Second Adjustment Appropriation Act, 2022

#### ACT

To effect adjustments to the appropriation of money from the Northern Cape Provincial Revenue Fund for the requirements of the Department of Roads and Public Works and the Department of Co-operative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs in respect of the financial year ending 31 March 2022; and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

#### **PREAMBLE**

WHEREAS the Northern Cape Main Appropriations Act, 2021 (Act No 1 of 2021), provides for the appropriation of money from the Provincial Revenue Fund to provide for the requirements of the Northern Cape Province in respect of the financial year ending 31 March 2022;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 31 of the Public Financial Management Act provides for the tabling of a provincial adjustments budget to make adjustments to the appropriations in the Provincial Appropriation Act;

BE IT ENACTED by the Northern Cape Provincial Legislature, as follows: —

#### 1. Definitions and interpretation

In this Act, unless the context indicates otherwise, any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Northern Cape Appropriations Act, 2021 (Act No, 1 of 2021), or the Public Finance Management Act, has the meaning assigned to it in those Acts, and —

"conditional grants" means allocations to provinces, local government or municipalities from the national government's share of revenue raised nationally, provided for in section 214(1)(c) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996:

"current payments" means any payments made by a provincial department in respect of the operational requirements of that department, and includes, amongst others, payments for the compensation of employees, goods and services, interest, rental of immovable property and financial transactions relating to assets and liabilities, but exclude transfers and subsidies, and payments for capital assets;

"payments for capital assets" means any payments made by a provincial department;

- for assets that can be used continuously or repeatedly in production for more than one year, and from which future economic benefits or service potential is expected to flow directly to the provincial department making the payment; and
- that must be classified as or deemed to be payments for capital assets in accordance with the "Reference Guide to the new Economic Format" (November 2003, Version 2) and the "Asset Management Framework" (April 2004, Version 3.3), issued by the National Treasury Undersection 76 of the Public Finance Management Act;

Northern Cape Second Adjustment Appropriation Act, 2022

"Public Finance Management Act" means the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999); and

"transfers and subsidies" means any payments made by a provincial department to another organ of state or any other person in respect of which the provincial department does not receive anything of similar value directly in return;

# 2. Appropriation of funding for the requirements of the Department of Roads and Public Works

- (1) Subject to the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999), as amended, there is hereby an allocation out of the Northern Cape Revenue Fund for the requirements of the Department of Roads and Public Works an amount of R28.931 million (Twenty-eight million, nine hundred thousand and thirty-one Rands), in respect of the 2021/22 financial year as set out in the Schedule.
- (2) The allocation contemplated in subsection (1) is meant to supplement provincial investments for road infrastructure maintenance (routine, periodic and special maintenance); to ensure that all roads are classified as per the Roads Infrastructure Strategic Framework for South Africa and the technical recommendations for highways, and the Road Classification and Access Management Guidelines.

# 3. Appropriation of funding for the requirements of the Department of Co-operative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs

- (1) Subject to the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999), as amended, there is hereby an allocation out of the Northern Cape Revenue Fund for the requirements of the Department of Co-operative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs an amount of R60 million (Sixty million Rands), in respect of the 2021/22 financial year as set out in the Schedule.
- (2) The allocation contemplated in subsection (1) is meant to provide funding to facilitate a programmatic and inclusive approach to upgrading informal settlements.

#### 4. Appropriation listed as specifically and exclusively

An appropriation to a vote or main divisions within a vote that is listed as specifically and exclusively appropriated in the Schedule may only be utilised for the purpose indicated and may not be used for any other purpose, unless an Act of the Northern Cape Provincial Legislature amends or changes the purpose for which it was allocated.

#### 5. Short title

This Act is called the Northern Cape Second Adjustment Appropriation Act, 2022.





#### **ACT**

To effect adjustments to the appropriation of money from the Northern Cape Provincial Revenue Fund for the requirements of the Northern Cape Province in respect of the financial year ending 31 March 2022; and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

#### **PREAMBLE**

**WHEREAS** Section 226(2) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996 provides that money may be withdrawn from the Provincial Revenue Fund only in terms of an appropriation by a provincial Act; or as a direct charge against the Provincial Revenue Fund, when it is provided for in the Constitution or a provincial Act.

**AND WHEREAS** the Northern Cape Appropriation Act, 2021 (Act No 1 of 2021), provides for the appropriation of money from the Provincial Revenue Fund to provide for the requirements of the Northern Cape Province in respect of the financial year ending 31 March 2022;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 31 of the Public Financial Management Act provides for the tabling of a provincial adjustments budget to make adjustments to the appropriations in the Provincial Appropriation Act;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Northern Cape Provincial Legislature, as follows:—

#### **Definitions and interpretation**

In this Act, unless the context indicates otherwise, any word or expression to which a
meaning has been assigned in the Northern Cape Appropriation Act, 2021 (Act No, 1 of
2021), or the Public Finance Management Act, has the meaning assigned to it in those
Acts, and —

"current payments" means any payments made by a provincial department in respect of the operational requirements of that department, and includes, amongst others, payments for the compensation of employees, goods and services, interest, rental of immovable property and financial transactions relating to assets and liabilities, but exclude transfers and subsidies, and payments for capital assets;

"payments for capital assets" means any payments made by a provincial department

(a) for assets that can be used continuously or repeatedly in production for more than one year, and from which future economic benefits or service potential is expected to flow directly to the provincial department making the payment; and

(b) that must be classified as or deemed to be payments for capital assets in accordance with the "Reference Guide to the new Economic Format" (November 2003, Version 2) and the "Asset Management Framework" (April 2004, Version 3.3), issued by the National Treasury under section 76 of the Public Finance Management Act;

"Public Finance Management Act" means the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999).

"transfers and subsidies" means any payments made by a provincial department to another organ of state or any other person in respect of which the provincial department does not receive anything of similar value directly in return;

Appropriation of adjusted amounts of money for the requirements of the Northern Cape Province.

- 2. (1) Adjusted appropriations by the Northern Cape Provincial Legislature of money from the Northern Cape Provincial Revenue Fund for the requirements of the Northern Cape Province in the 2021/22 financial year to votes and main divisions within a vote, and for the specific listed purposes, are set out in the Schedule to this Act.
  - (2) The spending of appropriations contemplated in subsection (1) is subject to the provisions of the Public Finance Management Act.

#### Short title

3. This Act is called the Northern Cape Adjustments Appropriation Act, 2021.
