

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 57(1)(a) of the Town Planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance 15 of 1986) that the **Madibeng Local Municipality** has approved the amendment of the Town Planning Scheme in operation known as the **Brits Amendment Scheme, 1/1958**, by the rezoning of **Erven 5411, 5418, 5419, 5420, 5421, 5430, 5455, 5471, 5474, 5484, 5485, 5486, 5487, 5492 and 5493 Brits Extension 156** as well as **Erven 5523, 5524 and 5526 Brits Extension 157** from **Special Residential with a density of 1 dwelling unit per erf** to **Special residential with a density of 2 dwelling units per erf (1 dwelling unit per 500m²)** also **Erven 5388 and 5389 Brits Extension 156** as well as **Erven 5505, 5506 and 5507 Brits Extension 157** from **General Residential with a density of 20 dwelling units per hectare** to **General Residential with a density of 40 dwelling units per hectare**.
