I, Ms. Mireille Wenger, Provincial Minister of Finance and Economic Opportunities in the Western Cape, in terms of section 71(7) of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act (No. 56 of 2003), publish the consolidated statement on municipal budgets in the Western Cape Province. The consolidated statement reflects the financial performance of municipalities as at the end of the second quarter (ending 31 December 2022) of the 2022/23 municipal financial year.

The Provincial Treasury uses National Treasury's Database as the primary source for the information reported in this publication. Although every effort has been made to compile a reliable set of numbers, the quality and completeness of the information is affected by the credibility of reports submitted by municipalities.

SUMMARY ON THE STATE OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE: SECOND QUARTER CONSOLIDATED STATEMENT FOR THE PERIOD 1 OCTOBER 2022 - 31 DECEMBER 2022

BACKGROUND

Section 71(7) of the Municipal Finance Management Act (MFMA) requires that the Provincial Treasury must, within 30 days after the end of each quarter, make public as may be prescribed, a consolidated statement in the prescribed format on the state of municipalities' budgets per municipality and per municipal entity.

This publication forms part of the In-Year Management, Monitoring and Reporting System for Local Government which enables the Provincial Treasury (PT) to exercise oversight over municipalities in the Western Cape. It provides a high-level review of the implementation of municipal budgets for the second quarter, ending 31 December 2022.

DATA USED

National Treasury's Local Government Database is the primary data source used for this publication. The quality of the report is subject to the credibility of the municipal Standard Chart of Accounts (mSCOA) data string information submitted by the tenth working day of each month and is compromised when municipalities fail to submit all the required data strings.

Some anomalies were noted in the submissions made by municipalities which have a significant impact on the credibility of the financial information reported for the period ending 31 December 2022. Discrepancies on key indicators were observed on the negative cash and cash equivalent budgets and year-to-date actuals reported by some municipalities as well as misalignments on capital funding and expenditure.

In an effort to assist municipalities to submit credible mSCOA data strings, PT has institutionalised an mSCOA segments use analysis tool which is shared with municipalities on a monthly basis. PT also has technical engagements with municipalities to discuss mSCOA findings. Municipalities are required to develop an action plan indicating specific timelines to resolve issues identified so that PT can keep track of the progress made by municipalities monthly.

Despite the challenges, Western Cape municipalities are committed to improving the quality of information with support from the National and Provincial Treasuries.

The data presented in this gazette provides a summary of the budget implementation performance against key indicators for all municipalities in the province. The data used was extracted on 20 January 2023 and detailed information for each municipality is available to the public in the section 71 files published at mfma.treasury.gov.za.

AGGREGATED TRENDS

1. On aggregate, Western Cape municipalities spent R37.91 billion or 41.8 per cent of the total expenditure budget of R90.74 billion by the end of the second quarter on 31 December 2022 (actual operating expenditure accounted for R34.62 billion and actual capital expenditure for R3.29 billion).
2. In respect of revenue, aggregate billing and other revenue amounted to R42.84 billion or 47.8 per cent of the total revenue budget of R89.70 billion (actual operating revenue accounted for R39.47 billion and actual capital revenue for R3.37 billion).

3. The aggregate operating revenue for the period ended 31 December 2022 amounted to R39.47 billion or 50.6 per cent of the operating revenue budget of R77.96 billion which represents an over performance of 2.9 per cent against year-to-date projections.
4. Service charges and property rates are the largest revenue sources, contributing 48.4 per cent and 19.6 per cent, respectively towards the total operating revenue budget of R77.96 billion. This is consistent with past trends.
5. For the quarter under review property rates overperformed by R171.88 million or 2.2 per cent, the overperformance is mainly due to some property rates being levied on an annual basis in July 2022, rather than monthly. However, a slight underperformance in service charges of 2.8 per cent is noted. This is due to the underperformance of R526.02 million or 4 per cent in respect of the electricity revenue which may be attributable to the ongoing loadshedding. The service charges and property rates revenue represent billed revenue and not actual revenue collected. Municipalities must stringently implement debt collection strategies to realise planned revenue.
6. To date municipalities spent R34.62 billion or 43.8 per cent of their aggregated R78.98 billion operating expenditure budget. Employee related costs is the highest cost driver, amounting to R11.88 billion or 34.3 per cent of the total operating expenditure to date, followed by materials and bulk purchases of R11.01 billion or 31.8 per cent and other expenditure amounting to R8.44 billion or 24.4 per cent of total operating expenditure to date.
7. Operating expenditure underperformed by R2.86 billion or 7.6 per cent against the year-to-date operating budget as at the end of December 2022. A year-on-year comparison indicates an increase in operating expenditure of 9.3 per cent, growth that exceeds inflation.
8. As at the end of December 2022, an aggregated operating surplus of R4.85 billion against a budgeted operating deficit of R1.03 billion was reported. The surplus may be due to some municipalities reducing spending in-year in line with their limited available revenue and cash. However, it was also noted that several municipalities are not yet reporting on their non-cash items (debt impairment and depreciation), this significantly understates the operating expenditure to date and results in an exaggerated operating surplus.
9. Municipalities in the Western Cape spent R3.29 billion or 28.0 per cent of their aggregated R11.76 billion capital budget to date. Spending is slow with an underperformance of 24.1 per cent when compared to the budgeted year-to-date performance. However, the year-on-year comparison shows an increase in actual spending in the current year of 10.3 per cent.
10. The City of Cape Town reported spending of R2.17 billion (28.8 per cent of the original budget) which is an underperformance of 6.1 per cent against the year-to-date budget. Secondary cities (Drakenstein, George and Stellenbosch municipalities) reported aggregated capital expenditure performance of R465.34 million or 35.0 per cent against their combined capital budget of R1.33 billion which is an underperformance of 16.7 per cent against the aggregated year-to-date budget. The consolidated capital budget spending for district municipalities amounted to R12.01 million or 4.3 per cent of their total budget of R279.23 million which is an underperformance of 85.1 per cent against the aggregated year-to-date budget. Local municipalities' capital spending amounted to R648.21 million or 24.7 per cent against their aggregated capital budget of R2.62 billion representing an underperformance of 53.3 per cent against their aggregated year-to-date budget. Municipalities' capital spending is largely dependent on the timeous completion of supply chain processes such as advertisement of bids, evaluating and awarding of the contracts to successful bidders. These processes will likely be accelerated as the financial year progresses or budgets will be revised during the adjustment budget process.

11. In aggregate, Western Cape municipalities fund 67.4 per cent of their total planned capital investment from own funding (an increase from the 62.1 per cent budgeted in the prior year). This comprises internally generated funds (37.9 per cent) and borrowings (29.4 per cent). 15 municipalities planned to take up loans when adopting their final budgets. Only two (2) municipalities have taken up new loans in the current year. The planned borrowing budget may be revised downwards during the main adjustments budget process, given higher interest rates and greater uncertainty.
12. Capital spending funded from borrowings amounted to R826.15 million or 23.9 per cent against the borrowing budget of R3.46 billion. Capital spending funded from transfers amounted to R1.28 billion or 33.4 per cent against the budgeted amount of R3.83 billion. Internally generated funds utilised amounted to R1.26 billion or 28.3 per cent against the budget of R4.46 billion.
13. The aggregate municipal consumer debtors balance as at 31 December 2022 amounted to R13.64 billion. The bulk of the outstanding debt is owed by households, which account for R9.91 billion or 72.7 per cent of the total outstanding debt.
14. Debtors older than 90 days amounted to R9.05 billion or 66.4 per cent of the total outstanding debtors of R13.64 billion. This includes historic debt that has accumulated over an extended period, interest on arrears and other recoveries.
15. Outstanding debtors have increased by R168.99 million or 1.3 per cent, from the R13.47 billion reported at the end of the first quarter of 2022/23 to R13.64 billion at the end of the second quarter of 2022/23. Debtors over 90 days increased by R207.55 million or 2.4 per cent during the second quarter.
16. In aggregate, Western Cape municipalities reported outstanding creditors of R540.17 million as at 31 December 2022. Total outstanding creditors older than 30 days amounted to R272.49 million or 50.4 per cent of the total. Municipalities cited various reasons for payments that are owed for more than 30 days.
17. Four (4) municipalities in the Western Cape collectively owe Eskom an amount of R267.82 million in outstanding payments overdue for more than 30 days. Each of the four (4) municipalities has engaged Eskom on their repayment arrangements.
18. The total cash and cash equivalents reported by municipalities as at the end of the second quarter amounted to R70.5 billion. However, this amount is overstated and does not align with figures in the Municipal Budget and Reporting Regulations (MBRR) schedules reported to municipal councils.
19. Provincial Treasury will continue to provide support to municipalities including guidance and support with mSCOA implementation, budget verifications, annual budget and in-year monitoring workshops, capacity building training initiatives, quarterly Chief Financial Officers' and Municipal Accountants Fora as well as facilitating the reduction of government debt owed to municipalities in conjunction with various government departments.
