By prescribing the keeping of records with the rendering of returns on an individual basis, market information for the whole of the industry can be processed and disseminated.

The continuation of the measure should assist in promoting the efficiency of the marketing of products. The viability of the wine industry should thus be enhanced. The measure will not be detrimental to the number of employment opportunities or fair labor practice. Any information obtained will be dealt with in a confidential manner and no sensitive or potentially sensitive client-specific information will be made available to any party without the prior approval of the party whose rights are affected.

The measure will be administered by SAWIS, a company incorporated under section 21 of the Companies Act, 1973. SAWIS will continue to implement and administer the measure as set out in the Schedule.

2) Information Levy

The Information levy is to be used to defray the expenses of SAWIS in its continued implementation, administration and enforcement of the statutory measures relating to registration and records and returns and in its processing, auditing, verification and dissemination of information thus acquired.

The information levy is needed by SAWIS to fund the registration of industry role players, and ensure the collection and dissemination of information.

According to the applicant a concerted drive by all exporters to promote the exports of South African wines is an absolute prerequisite for the future sustainability of the South African wine industry. Other new world wine producing countries like Australia, New Zealand, California, etc spend vast amounts of money (mostly derived from government and/or statutory levies) on generically promoting their wines on the highly competitive various export markets. In order to be competitive South Africa simply has to continue to

promote South African wines generically. The specific exporter then has to promote his individual brand based on the image created for South African wines.

According to the applicant the objectives of a generic export promotional campaign in order to enhance the sustainability of the industry are the following:

- To increase the rand/case profit or return in each focus market - this will be driven by a proactive PR campaign to enhance South Africa's image as a quality producer.
- To increase activities in new markets in order to provide opportunities for export growth in new markets.
- To increase infrastructural support for the industry as regards export procedures and market research.

SUID-AFRIKAANSE INKOMSTEDIENS****No. 743****17 August 2001****INCOME TAX: SHORT-TERM INSURANCE BUSINESS: WITHDRAWAL OF CONTINGENCY RESERVE**

1. In terms of section 28 (2) of the Income Tax Act, 1962, the Commissioner for the South African Revenue Service (the Commissioner) exercised his discretion during 1989 to allow a reserve, generally known as the Contingency Reserve (the Reserve), in determining the taxable income of a short-term insurer. The manner in which the Reserve was to be allowed is set out in Practice Note 10, dated 14 July 1989.

2. The reason for one of the amendments to the Insurance Act in 1989 was to establish an additional compulsory ten percent solvency margin to bring the margins provided for in the Act in line with a generally acceptable industry level. This was deemed necessary to provide additional stability to the insurance industry in order to meet any unusually severe claims arising as a result of, for example, natural disasters or other catastrophic, but unforeseen events. Opportunity for re-insurance was also very limited. The decision by the Commissioner to allow for the additional reserve was taken against this background and in response to a request to provide relief for a substantial cash flow problem that would arise.

3. In view of changed circumstances, the fact that the reserves of short term insurers have been generally fully funded and access to reinsurance providers are no longer limited, the view is held that there is no longer a necessity for the reserve to be allowed for tax purposes.

4. Accordingly notice is hereby given that Practice Note No. 10 dated 14 July 1989 is withdrawn and that the Commissioner will exercise the discretion provided for in section 28 (2) of the Act in the following manner:

- (a) The calculated reserve as at the end of the year of assessment of a short-term insurer that ends during the 12 months period ending on 30 June 2001 will be phased out over the immediately following two years of assessment.
- (b) In the case of a company which changed its financial year-end and did not have a year of assessment ending during the 12 months period ending on 30 June 2001, the calculated reserve as at the end of its first year of assessment ending after that period will be phased out over the immediately following two years of assessment.

The amount to be allowed in respect of the reserve for the first year of assessment of the phase out will be 50% of the calculated reserve and in the second year of assessment of the phase out 0% of the calculated reserve.

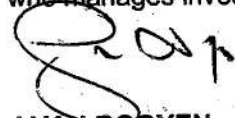

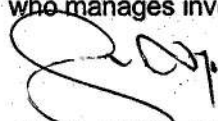

SCHEDULE

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER THE SECURITY OFFICERS ACT, 1987 (ACT NO. 92 OF 1987)

The Security Officers' Interim Board has, with the concurrence of the Deputy Minister for Safety and Security, acting on behalf of and on assignment by the Minister for Safety and Security, under section 32(1) of the Security Officers Act, 1987 (Act No. 92 of 1987) made the Regulations in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE**AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS MADE UNDER THE SECURITY OFFICERS ACT, 1987 (ACT NO. 92 OF 1987)****Definition**

1. In this Schedule "the Regulations" means the regulations published by Government Notice No. R. 797 in *Government Gazette* No. 12413 of 2 April 1990, as amended.

Commencement

2. The amendments of the Regulations contained in this Schedule will come into effect on a date determined for such purpose by the Security Officers' Interim Board.

Amendment of regulation 1 of the Regulations

3. Regulation 1 of the Regulations is hereby amended –

- (a) by the substitution for the definition of "prescribed fees" of the following definition:

"prescribed fees" means the fees referred to in regulation 9(2);

- (b) by the insertion after the definition of "police official" of the following definition:

"prescribed amount" in regard to a security business means the applicable amount contemplated in regulation 9(3) and in the case of any person not acting as a security business the amount contemplated in regulation 9(4);

- (c) by the insertion after the definition of "Registrar of the Board" of the following definition:

"security business" means a company, close corporation, sole proprietor, partnership or business trust registered as a security officer;

- (d) by the insertion after the definition of "security business" of the following definition:

"serve", in relation to any document required in terms of these regulations to be served on any person, means to deliver, or offer to deliver, a copy of the document personally to such person, or at such person's employment, business or residential address to any person

over the age of 16 years that resides or is employed at such address”.

Substitution of regulation 7 of the Regulations

4. The following regulation is hereby substituted for regulation 7 of the Regulations:

“Payment of prescribed amounts and related matters

7(1) Every security business must within seven (7) days after the end of each calendar month furnish to the Board, in writing, a return with the full name, identity number, the registration number of a person registered by the Board in terms of section 11(3) of the Act, and the period of service during that month, of every person employed, used, deployed or made available by it for the rendering of a security service during that month or any part of that month.

(2) The prescribed amount must, subject to section 18(4)(a) of the Act, be paid to the Board either in accordance with sub-regulation (3) or in accordance with sub-regulation (4) of this regulation.

(3)(a) The full prescribed amount for a calendar year must, subject to this sub-regulation, be paid to the Board before or on 1 April of the calendar year concerned.

(b) In the case of a security business becoming registered in terms of section 11 of the Act on or after 1 April in a given calendar year, the prescribed amount in respect of that year must be paid as provided for in sub-regulation (4).

(c) In the case of a security business intending to pay in accordance with paragraph (a) of this sub-regulation –

- (i) notice of such an intention must be given to the Board in writing on or before 20 January of the calendar year in question, failing of which the prescribed amount will be payable as provided for in sub-regulation (4);
- (ii) the prescribed amount payable for the calendar year is, subject to the provisions of paragraph (e), determined in accordance with regulation 9(3) on the basis of the highest number of persons employed, used, deployed or made available by the security business in question for the rendering of a security service at any time in any of the three calendar months preceding April of the calendar year in question and it is deemed for the purposes of calculating the prescribed amount for the calendar year in question that the said number of persons is so employed, used, deployed or made available for every month of that calendar year.

(d) The Board must, within a reasonable time after the end of each calendar year, calculate the amount that should have been paid in accordance with regulation 9(3) by every security business which has elected to pay in terms of the method provided for in this sub-regulation, taking into account the actual number of persons employed,

used, deployed or made available by the security business for the purpose of rendering a security service in each of the twelve (12) months of the calendar year in question, and may, by a written notice served on a security business, require from that business any additional information or documentation needed by the Board for this calculation to be furnished to it within the period provided for in such notice.

(e) If, after the calculation referred to in paragraph (d) of this sub-regulation, there is a difference between the calculated amount and the amount already paid by the security business in terms of paragraph (c)(ii) of this sub-regulation –

- (i) the Board must refund to the security business any amount overpaid by it within thirty (30) days after the calculation has been completed; and
- (ii) the security business in question must pay to the Board any amount owing to the Board in terms of the said calculation within thirty (30) days after a notice from the Board in this regard has been served on it.

(4) A security business which does not pay the prescribed amount to the Board in terms of sub-regulation (3) of this regulation, must pay to the Board within seven (7) days after the end of each calendar month, commencing in January and ending in December, the applicable prescribed amount arrived at in terms of regulation 9(3).

(5) Nothing in this regulation prevents a written agreement being entered into between the Board and any security business regarding the method and date of payment of the prescribed amount.

(6) For the purpose of the un-expired portion of the calendar year January to December 2001 the prescribed amount will be payable only in terms of sub-regulation (4).

(7) Any security business which fails to pay to the Board, within the period allowed for such payment –

- (a) the prescribed amount payable in terms of this regulation;
- (b) the prescribed amount payable in terms of an agreement referred to in sub-regulation (5);
- (c) an amount contemplated in sub-regulation (3)(e)(ii) of this regulation; or
- (d) an amount deducted by it in terms of section 18(4)(a) of the Act -

must pay to the Board –

- (a) the unpaid amount;
 - (b) interest on the unpaid amount at the rate determined from time to time in terms of the Prescribed Rate of Interest Act, 1975 (Act No. 55 of 1975); and
 - (c) a penalty arrived at by calculating ten (10) per cent of that sum arrived at by adding to the unpaid amount the interest accrued thereon to date of calculation of the penalty:
- Provided that if the Board is satisfied that the failure by a person to pay or pay over any amount in terms of this regulation was not due to an intent to

evade or postpone payment or otherwise to evade obligations in terms of this regulation or the Act, it may remit the whole or part of the penalty imposed in terms of paragraph (c) of this sub-regulation.

(8) Any amount of interest and any penalty owing to the Board in terms of sub-regulation (7) will be regarded as part of the prescribed amount as contemplated in section 18(1) and section 18(2) of the Act.

(9) Any security business which -

- (a) fails to provide the Board with the return contemplated in sub-regulation (1) within the period allowed;
- (b) fails to provide the Board within the period allowed with the additional information required by the Board in terms of sub-regulation (3)(d);
- (d) intentionally or negligently submits a return to the Board which is materially false in any respect; or
- (e) fails to deduct an amount as contemplated in section 18(4)(a) of the Act from the remuneration of a security officer that it should have deducted,

will be guilty of an offence and on conviction liable to a fine not exceeding R1 000.

(10) Any director, member, owner, partner or trustee, according to the case, of a security business -

(a) who fails to take all reasonable steps to ensure that the security business of which he or she is a director, member, owner, partner or trustee, according to the case -

- (i) complies with an obligation in terms of sub-regulation (1);
- (ii) complies with an obligation in terms of sub-regulation (3)(d);
- (iii) complies with an obligation in terms of section 18(4)(a) of the Act to deduct an amount from the remuneration of a security officer; or

(b) who intentionally or negligently submits a return referred to in sub-regulation (1) to the Board or allows such a return to be submitted to the Board on behalf of the security business in question, which is materially false in any respect -

will be guilty of an offence and on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding R1 000 or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months or to both such fine and such imprisonment."

Repeal of regulation 8 of the Regulations

5. Regulation 8 of the Regulations is hereby repealed.

Amendment of regulation 9 of the Regulations

6. The following regulation is hereby substituted for regulation 9 of the Regulations:

"Prescribed fees and prescribed amounts

9(1) Value Added Tax (VAT) must be added to any fee or amount of money referred to in this regulation.

(2) The prescribed fee contemplated in section 11(1)(b) of the Act will be as follows-

(a) Every application for registration as a security officer by a security business for the purposes of regulation 2: R2 000.00.

(b) Application for registration as a security officer not falling under paragraph (a): R42.20.00.

(3) The prescribed amount contemplated in section 18(1) of the Act must, in the case of a security business registered as a security officer, be determined with reference to the following schedule:

Number of persons employed, used, deployed or made available by a security business for the purpose of rendering a security service for a calendar month or any part thereof	Amount payable per month
0 - 50	R250.00
51 - 100	R500.00
101 - 250	R750.00
251 - 500	R1 000.00
501 - 1 000	R2 000.00
1 001 - 2 500	R3 000.00
2 501 - 5 000	R4 000.00
5 001 or more	R5 000.00

(4) The prescribed amount contemplated in section 18(1) of the Act must in the case of a person registered as a security officer, not acting as a security business, be arrived at as follows:

R84.00 per calendar year:

Provided that the said amount will be decreased by R7.00 in respect of every full calendar month that a security officer was not registered as such during that year."

Authoritative text

7. The provisions of the English text of the Regulations will prevail in the case of a difference between the English text and any other text.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM REGARDING THE DRAFT PROPOSED REGULATIONS

1. The draft proposed regulations provide for an increase, on a differentiated basis, in the annual amounts payable by certain registered security officers (security businesses) to the Security Officers' Interim Board, and for matters incidental thereto. The draft further provides for certain improvements to the applicable regulations.
2. The draft regulations contain amendments to the definition of "prescribed fee" and insert definitions of "prescribed amount" of "security business" and of "serve".
3. The existing regulation 7 is to be replaced by a new and more detailed and practical regulation. The draft regulation 7 places a duty on security businesses to furnish the Board with certain important information on a monthly basis. It further provides for two methods of paying annual amounts. A written agreement between a security business and the Board on how the applicable amount is to be paid, is also made possible. As is customary in such instances, provision is made for mora interest and a 10% penalty to be added to unpaid amounts. Certain offences are created in order to help ensure compliance with statutory duties by security businesses.
4. The existing regulation 8 is repealed.
5. The existing regulation 9 is to be replaced by a new provision. The prescribed fees for applicants who seek registration as security officer remain the same. The same applies in regard to annual amounts in respect of individual security officers. However, a new differentiated fee structure is proposed in regard to the annual amounts payable by registered security businesses. It is clear from the schedule contained in draft regulation 9(3) how the proposed system will work. A differentiated fee structure is necessary, *inter alia* -
 - to ensure a more realistic and equitable distribution of the financial burden of regulation across the spectrum of security businesses of different sizes;
 - to be more consistent with the actual cost of regulating security businesses of different sizes; and
 - to further alleviate the disproportionate financial burden of regulation still borne by individual security officers.
6. If finally approved, the draft regulations will come into effect on a date determined by the Security Officers' Interim Board for this purpose.
7. It is provided that the English text of the regulations will prevail in the case of a difference between it and any other text.
8. The Government views the regulation of the vast private security industry as of key national importance in order to achieve and maintain a legitimate security industry. It goes without saying that the Security Officers' Interim Board, entrusted with such regulation, must have sufficient financial resources to properly perform its regulatory functions. The draft proposed regulations dealing with financial matters would improve the position of the Board to achieve its important statutory objects.
