CLASSIFICATION OF ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by sub-section (3) of section *seventy-one bis* of the Liquor Act, 1928 (Act No. 30 of 1928), I, BALTHAZAR JOHANNES VORSTER, Minister of Justice of the Republic of South Africa, hereby—

(a) make known that accommodation establishments shall be classified in the classes set out in column I of the First Schedule hereto and that such establishments in respect of which hotel liquor licences have been issued, shall be graded in the grades set out in column II of the said Schedule;

KLASSIFIKASIE VAN AKKOMMODASIE-INRIGTINGS.

Ek, BALTHAZAR JOHANNES VORSTER, Minister van Justisie van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika, handelende kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by subartikel (3) van artikel *een-en-sewentig bis* van die Drankwet, 1928 (Wet No. 30 van 1928)—

(a) maak hierby bekend dat akkommodasie-inrigtings geklassifiseer moet word in die klasse in kolom I van die Eerste Bylae hiervan uiteengesit, en dat sodanige inrigtings ten opsigte waarvan hoteldranklisensies uitgereik is, in die grade in kolom II van genoemde Bylae uiteengesit, gegradeer moet word;

- (b) prescribe the requirements set out in the Second Schedule hereto as being the minimum requirements for the different grades of accommodation establishments in respect of which hotel liquor licences have been issued, with which such establishments shall comply before application may be made under subsection (1) of the said section *seventy-one bis*;
- (c) prescribe the requirements set out in the Third Schedule hereto as being the minimum requirements for all the different grades of accommodation establishments referred to in paragraph (b), with which such establishments shall comply in addition to the minimum requirements set out in the Second Schedule, before application may be made under sub-section (1) of the said section *seventy-one bis*.

In the Second and Third Schedules, unless the context otherwise indicates—

“bed-/sittingroom” shall mean a permanent lounge separated from the sleeping portion by means of a low wall or a curtain or some other acceptable means, a bathroom and toilet facilities, as a unit;

“bedroom with bathroom” shall mean one bedroom, a bathroom and toilet facilities, as a unit;

“bedroom with shower” shall mean one bedroom, a shower and toilet facilities, as a unit;

“light refreshments” shall mean tea, coffee, milk, mineral waters and biscuits;

“ordinary bedroom” shall mean one bedroom (without a bathroom or shower and toilet facilities, as a unit);

“suite” shall mean a permanent lounge, bedroom(s), bathroom(s) and toilet facilities, as a unit;

“tiled” shall mean tiled by means of porcelain or ceramic tiles or marble or some other approved equivalent impervious material, not being paint;

and a word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Liquor Act, 1928, shall bear that meaning.

Tolerance factor 1.—Where an accommodation establishment does not fully comply with the minimum requirements under this heading in respect of the percentage bedrooms with bathrooms and bedrooms with showers, the Minister may, upon the recommendation of the National Liquor Board, agree that not more than 10% of the total number of bedrooms in the establishment concerned may be ordinary bedrooms.

Tolerance factor 2.—Where an accommodation establishment does not fully comply with the minimum requirements under this heading in respect of the percentage bedrooms with bathrooms and bedrooms with showers, the Minister may, upon the recommendation of the National Liquor Board, agree that not more than 10% (and not more than 15% in the case of an establishment in respect of which a hotel liquor licence was granted and issued before the 1st July, 1964) of the total number of bedrooms in the establishment concerned, may be ordinary bedrooms.

Tolerance factor 3.—Where an accommodation establishment in respect of which a hotel liquor licence was granted and issued before 1st July, 1964, does not fully comply with the minimum requirements under this heading in respect of the percentage of bedrooms with bathrooms and bedrooms with showers, the Minister may, if he is satisfied that non-compliance with the requirement is due to circumstances beyond the applicant's control, upon the recommendation of the National Liquor Board, authorise a decrease of not more than 10% in the minimum percentage.

Tolerance factor 4.—If the Minister is satisfied that in the area in which the accommodation establishment is situated, the radio reception is such that an effective service cannot be provided, he may, upon the recommendation of the National Liquor Board, grant exemption from this minimum requirement.

Tolerance factor 5.—If upon the recommendation of the National Liquor Board, the Minister is satisfied that the nature of the floors of the accommodation establishment is such that non-compliance with this minimum requirement will not detract from the standard of that establishment, he may grant exemption from this requirement.

Tolerance factor 6.—If the minimum ratio between communal baths and beds is not complied with but apart from a number of bathrooms separate showers are also provided, the Minister may, upon the recommendation of the National Liquor Board, bring such showers into account in the proportion of one shower being equal to one bathroom: Provided that the number of bathrooms may never be less than 80% of the total number which is required under the minimum ratio.

Tolerance factor 7.—The Minister may, upon the recommendation of the National Liquor Board, grant exemption from this requirement in respect of an accommodation establishment in respect of which a hotel liquor licence was granted and issued before 1st July, 1964, if he is satisfied that non-compliance with this requirement is due to circumstances beyond the applicant's control or that non-compliance with this requirement will not detract from the standard of the establishment concerned.

Tolerance factor 8.—The Minister may, upon the recommendation of the National Liquor Board, grant exemption from this requirement if he is satisfied that a hairdressing salon as required is conveniently situated for guests in the immediate vicinity of the accommodation establishment.

General tolerance factor.—If an accommodation establishment in which a hotel liquor licence has been issued, complies with the minimum requirements of a particular grade, and in addition has additional facilities available and renders additional services which are not prescribed as minimum requirements for that particular grade, the Minister may, upon the recommendation of the National Liquor Board, and with due regard to such facilities and services, place that establishment in one grade higher than the grade the minimum requirements of which it complies with.

THIRD SCHEDULE.

Bedrooms for Guests.

- *1. Minimum floor area (inclusive of vestibule and built-in furniture, if any):—
 - (a) Single room: 120 sq. ft.
 - (b) Double room: 180 sq. ft.
- 2. Hot and cold running water to be laid on in each room or sleeping unit and to be available at all times.
- *3. A mirror and shelf to be provided at or near each wash basin and an area of 24 in. by 18 in. to be tiled immediately above such basin.
- 4. All mattresses to be inner-sprung and/or foam rubber or equivalent (exclusive of those intended for small children).
- 5. Width of beds 3 ft.
- 6. (a) Adequate electric lighting.
(b) A reading lamp at each bed with a switch in immediate vicinity of bed.
- 7. A dressing table and a wardrobe to be provided in each room (or in a room adjacent to and forming part of such room).
- 8. A chair to be provided for each bed.
- 9. A mirror at least 3 ft. long and 15 in. wide to be available in each bedroom..
- 10. A luggage stand to be provided.
- 11. (a) A serviceable and safe lock on each door and wardrobe.
(b) A key for each bedroom and wardrobe.
- 12. Adequate clothes hooks and hangers (not of wire) to be provided.
- 13. An electric bell or internal telephone to be provided.
- 14. If not carpeted throughout, one floor mat for each bed, size 2 ft. 3 in. by 4 ft. 6 in., or one floor mat, size 4 ft. 6 in. by 6 ft. 0 in., which serves all beds.
- 15. A waste-paper basket to be provided.

Toelatingsfaktor 1.—Waar 'n akkommodasie-inrigting nie ten volle voldoen aan die minimum vereistes ten opsigte van die persentasie slaapkamers met badkamers en slaapkamers met storte onder hierdie hoof nie, kan die Minister op aanbeveling van die Nasionale Drankraad toestem dat hoogstens 10% van die totale getal slaapkamers in die betrokke inrigting gewone slaapkamers kan wees.

Toelatingsfaktor 2.—Waar 'n akkommodasie-inrigting nie ten volle voldoen aan die minimum vereistes ten opsigte van die persentasie slaapkamers met badkamers en slaapkamers met storte onder hierdie hoof nie, kan die Minister op aanbeveling van die Nasionale Drankraad toestem dat hoogstens 10% (en hoogstens 15% in die geval van 'n inrigting ten opsigte waarvan 'n hoteldranklisensie voor 1 Julie 1964 verleen en uitgereik is) van die totale getal slaapkamers in die betrokke inrigting gewone slaapkamers kan wees.

Toelatingsfaktor 3.—Waar 'n akkommodasie-inrigting ten opsigte waarvan 'n hoteldranklisensie voor 1 Julie 1964 verleen en uitgereik is, nie ten volle voldoen aan die minimum vereistes ten opsigte van die persentasie slaapkamers met badkamers en slaapkamers met storte onder hierdie hoof nie, kan die Minister op aanbeveling van die Nasionale Drankraad 'n vermindering van hoogstens 10% in die minimum persentasie magtig indien hy daarvan oortuig is dat dié nie-nakoming van dié vereiste toe te skryf is aan omstandighede buite die beheer van die aanvrager.

Toelatingsfaktor 6.—Indien daar nie aan die minimum verhouding tussen gemeenskaplike badkamers en beddens voldoen word nie, maar benewens 'n aantal badkamers ook aparte storte verskaf word, kan die Minister op aanbeveling van die Nasionale Drankraad daardie storte in die verhouding van een stort gelykstaande met een badkamer: Met dien verstaande dat die getal badkamers nooit minder as 80% van die totale getal wat volgens die minimum verhouding vereis word, mag wees nie.

64. A sink (preferably stainless steel) with a tiled or stainless steel splashboard, and with hot and cold running water for the washing of glasses, to be provided in or near the bar.
 65. Adequate seating facilities for use of customers to be provided.

Dress.

66. All personnel must be suitably, cleanly and neatly dressed.

General.

67. The inside and outside of the building must at all times be clean and in good repair.
 68. All rooms must be properly ventilated.
 69. All furniture and equipment, kitchen utensils, cutlery, crockery, glassware, bedding, linen, curtains, carpets, mats and other floor coverings must be clean and kept in good order and no chipped or cracked crockery or glassware may be used.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION ONE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE OF THE LIQUOR ACT, 1928.—CLASSIFICATION AND GRADING OF ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section *one hundred and seventy-three* of the Liquor Act, 1928 (Act No. 30 of 1928), I, BALTHAZAR JOHANNES VORSTER, Minister of Justice, hereby make the regulations contained in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.**INTERPRETATION OF TERMS.**

1. In these regulations and in the forms contained in the Annexure thereto, unless the context otherwise indicates—

“bedroom with bathroom” shall mean one bedroom, a bathroom and toilet facilities, as a unit;

“bedroom with shower” shall mean one bedroom, a shower and toilet facilities, as a unit;

“bed/sitting room” shall mean a permanent lounge separated from the sleeping portion by means of a low wall or a curtain or some other acceptable means, a bathroom and toilet facilities, as a unit;

“class or grade” shall mean the class or the grade made known in the *Gazette* in terms of sub-section (3) of section *seventy-one bis* of the Act;

“minimum requirements” shall mean the minimum requirements prescribed under sub-section (3) of section *seventy-one bis* of the Act;

“National Board” shall mean the National Liquor Board established under section *one hundred and eighteen bis* of the Act;

“ordinary bedroom” shall mean one bedroom (without a bathroom or shower and toilet facilities, as a unit);

“suite” shall mean a permanent lounge, bedroom(s), bathroom(s) and toilet facilities, as a unit;

“the Act” shall mean the Liquor Act, 1928 (Act No. 30 of 1928);

and a word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act, shall bear that meaning.

Ontvangs van gaste.

 68. Alle vertrekke moet behoorlik geventileer wees.
 69. Alle meubels en uitrusting, kombuisgereedskap, eetgerei, breekware, glasware, beddegoed, linne, gordyne, tapyte, matte en ander vloerbedekkings moet skoon wees en in 'n goeie toestand gehou word en geen uitgehapte of gebarste breekgoed of glasware mag gebruik word nie.

BYLAE.**WOORDOMSKRYWING.**

1. In hierdie regulasies en in die vorms in die Aanhangsel daarvan vervat, tensy uit die samehang anders blyk, beteken—

„die Wet” die Drankwet, 1928 (Wet No. 30 van 1928); „gewone slaapkamer” een slaapkamer (sonder 'n badkamer of stort en toiletgeriewe, as 'n eenheid);

„kamerstel” 'n permanente sitkamer, slaapkamer(s), badkamer(s) en toiletgeriewe, as 'n eenheid;

APPLICATION FOR CLASSIFICATION AND GRADING IN TERMS OF SECTION *seventy-one bis* OF THE ACT.

2. (1) The proprietor or lessee of an accommodation establishment desiring to apply for the classification and grading of such establishment, shall do so in writing substantially in the form of Form No. 1 contained in the Annexure and furnish in the application such information as is solicited in the said form.

(2) Every such application shall be accompanied by—

- (a) a description of the premises and a plan drawn to scale clearly showing the dimensions and arrangements of the internal structure, together with all doors, windows and means of internal and external communication, and the streets or places to which such means of external communication lead: Provided that no such plan shall be necessary in the case of any subsequent application in respect of the same premises if the applicant with such application submits an affidavit that since the last application for classification and grading the premises have undergone no change or have undergone only a minor change of structural arrangement, full particulars of which shall be given in such affidavit, or that the premises have undergone a major change of structural arrangement which has been approved in accordance with the conditions attached to the certificate of classification;
- (b) a power of attorney granted by his nominator, if the applicant applies in the capacity of a nominee;
- (c) conclusive proof that notice of intention to make the application has been given in terms of regulation 3;
- (d) a true copy of the liquor licence and any annexures thereto, issued in respect of the accommodation establishment concerned.

(3) An applicant may attach to his application such representations in writing in support thereof as he may desire should be taken into account in the consideration thereof.

(4) Every such application, together with the documents and representations referred to in sub-regulations (2) and (3), shall be lodged with the magistrate of the district in which the accommodation establishment forming the subject of the application is situated.

(5) The application for classification and grading, together with the documents and representations referred to in sub-regulations (2) and (3), shall be lodged, in triplicate, in terms of sub-regulation (4) at least six weeks but not more than eight weeks before the first day of the month in which it must be considered by the National Board, unless the Minister or the person acting under his directions otherwise consents: Provided that if a certificate of classification has been issued in terms of subsection (4) of section *seventy-one bis* of the Act, and it is desired to apply for the reclassification and grading of the accommodation establishment for a further period of three years, application for such classification and grading shall be lodged in terms of this regulation at least eight weeks but not more than ten weeks before the date upon which the certificate of classification issued, expires.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO APPLY FOR CLASSIFICATION AND GRADING.

3. A proprietor or lessee referred to in sub-regulation (1) of regulation 2, shall at least four days before the date upon which he lodges his application in terms of sub-regulation (5) of the said regulation notify his intention to do so by notice in Afrikaans and in English in a bilingual newspaper or in an Afrikaans and an English newspaper circulating in the district in which the premises concerned are situate, substantially in the form of Form No. 2 contained in the Annexure.

INSPECTION OF AND OBJECTION TO APPLICATION FOR CLASSIFICATION AND GRADING.

4. (1) During a period of fourteen days from the date upon which an application for classification and grading has been lodged with a magistrate, any person may, upon request and free of charge, inspect it and the documents

The magistrate shall, not earlier than fourteen days from the receipt of an application, forward it together with the documents and representations referred to in sub-regulations (2) and (3) of regulation 2 as well as any written objection and reply thereto and the report of the person designated under regulation 5, in duplicate to the Secretary for Justice for submission to the National Board and shall furnish such further information and comments in respect of the application as he may deem fit.

MEETINGS OF THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS FOR CLASSIFICATION AND GRADING.

7. (1) Unless otherwise directed by the Minister, the National Board shall meet—

- (a) during the month of August, 1964, for the consideration of applications in respect of accommodation establishments which comply with the minimum requirements for the De Luxe, Five-Star and Four-Star Grades and all accommodation establishments for non-Whites which comply with the minimum requirements for hotels for non-Whites;
- (b) during the month of October, 1964, for the consideration of applications in respect of accommodation establishments which comply with the minimum requirements for the Three-Star and Two-Star Grades;
- (c) during the month of December, 1964, for the consideration of applications in respect of accommodation establishments which comply with the minimum requirements for the One-Star Grade;
- (d) during the month of July of each successive year for the consideration of any application for classification and grading of an accommodation establishment in respect of which a certificate of classification has not previously been issued;
- (e) on such date as may be determined by the chairman of the said Board for the consideration of any application for the reclassification and grading of an accommodation establishment in respect of which a certificate of classification was previously issued.

(2) The National Board shall meet at such place as may be determined by the chairman thereof.

(3) The National Board may—

- (a) by written notice under the hand of its chairman require the attendance before it of any applicant, or objector or person designated under regulation 5, or any person who, in the opinion of the Board, is able to give information as regards any application for classification and grading which it has to consider;
- (b) inspect any accommodation establishment in respect of which an application under sub-section (1) of section seventy-one bis of the Act has been made.

- (b) is a partner, agent or employee of the applicant or any objector to the application;
- (c) is a director, manager or other officer, employee or agent of any person who has a financial interest in the accommodation establishment in respect of which the application is made;
- (d) has any financial interest in the accommodation establishment concerned or in the business conducted therein.

CERTIFICATE OF CLASSIFICATION.

12. If an application for classification and grading is granted, a certificate of classification substantially in the form of Form No. 3 contained in the Annexure shall be issued to the applicant.

13. A person to whom a certificate of classification has been issued, shall at all times during the currency thereof display, at a prominent place in the accommodation establishment concerned, the original or a true copy thereof, together with any annexures thereto.

FEE PAYABLE IN RESPECT OF APPLICATION FOR CLASSIFICATION AND GRADING.

14. (1) When lodging an application in terms of regulation 2 with a magistrate, the applicant shall pay to that magistrate an amount of fifty rand in respect thereof.

(2) The fee payable in terms of sub-regulation (1) shall be reduced by one half if, before the expiration of the period for which a certificate of classification has been issued, an application for the reclassification and grading of the accommodation establishment in respect of which such certificate was issued, is lodged in terms of regulation 2.
