MAXIMUM PRICES OF SUGAR

By virtue of the powers conferred on me by the Price Controller under section 3 of the Price Control Act, 1964 (Act 25 of 1964), I, Elias George de Beer, Deputy Price Controller, do hereby under section 4 of the said Act amend Government Notice R. 515 of 1 April 1977 as follows:

(a) Paragraph 1 of the Third Schedule is hereby amended by the substitution for all prices appearing against the district of Waterberg of the following prices:

MAXIMUM PRICE OF SUGAR

1. In terms of the provisions contained in the Price Control Act, 1948 (Act No. 103 of 1948), the Department of Commerce has decided to fix a maximum price for sugar for the period 1 April 1977 to 31 March 1978.

2. The maximum price for sugar shall be as follows:

Grade	1977/78	1978/79	1979/80	1980/81
White	1.25	1.30	1.35	1.40
Yellow	1.15	1.20	1.25	1.30

3. The maximum price for sugar shall be subject to the following conditions:

(a) The maximum price shall be applicable to all sugar produced in the Republic of South Africa.

(b) The maximum price shall be applicable to all sugar imported into the Republic of South Africa.

White	1.25	1.30	1.35	1.40
Yellow	1.15	1.20	1.25	1.30

4. The maximum price for sugar shall be subject to the following conditions:

(a) The maximum price shall be applicable to all sugar produced in the Republic of South Africa.

(b) The maximum price shall be applicable to all sugar imported into the Republic of South Africa.
