PROCLAMATION

DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY

Whereas in my opinion it appears that circumstances have arisen in the areas mentioned in the Schedule which seriously threaten the safety of the public and the maintenance of public order; and the ordinary law of the land is inadequate to enable the Government to ensure the safety of the public and to maintain public order,

Therefore I, in terms of section 2 (1) of the Public Safety Act, 1953 (Act 3 of 1953), hereby declare that as from 21 July 1985 a state of emergency exists within the areas mentioned in the Schedule.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Republic of South Africa at Pretoria this Twentieth day of July, One thousand Nine hundred and Eighty-five.
