## PROCLAMATION

*by the*

***President of the Republic of South Africa***

**No. R. 56, 1995**

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER THE VENDA GOVERNMENT SERVICE PENSIONS ACT, 1979  
(ACT NO. 4 OF 1979)

Under the powers vested in me under section 235 (7) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1993 (Act No. 200 of 1993), and after consultation with the Premier of the Province of Northern Transvaal, I hereby make the regulations under section 11 of the Venda Government Service Pensions Act, 1979 (Act No. 4 of 1979), as set out in the Schedule.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Republic of South Africa at Cape Town this First day of June, One thousand Nine hundred and Ninety-five.

**SCHEDULE****Definition**

1. (1) In these regulations, unless the context indicates otherwise, any word to which a meaning has been assigned in the Venda Government Service Pensions Act, 1979 (Act No. 4 of 1979), as amended, the regulations published under section 11 of the Venda Government Service Pensions Act, 1979, and any law pertaining to the Pension Fund or the Superannuation Fund, shall bear that meaning.

(2) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise indicates—

“**accrued benefits**”, has the same meaning as “actuarial share”;

“**actuarial share**”, means an amount determined according to the revised formula;

“**member**”, means a member of the Pension Fund or the Superannuation Fund, as the case may be;

“**the Act**”, means the Venda Government Service Pensions Act, 1979 (Act No. 4 of 1979);

“**the Fund**”, means the Pension Fund or the Superannuation Fund, as the case may be;

“**the revised formula**”, means  $N \times S \times F$  in which—

N is the years of service of the member;

S is the annual pensionable emoluments of the member on 29 March 1992;

F is the factor set out in Annexure A.

2. Any member of the Fund, who made an election in terms of section 10A (1) of the Act, shall be paid from the Fund, an amount equal to his or her accrued benefit in the Fund.

3. The payment of any amount in terms of regulation 2, shall be subject to—

(1) the premise that the funding level of the Fund is, and at all times was 75%.
