ALIENS CONTROL ACT (ACT No. 96 OF 1991)

SIXTH AMENDMENT OF THE ALIENS CONTROL REGULATIONS (FEES)

The Minister of Home Affairs has, in terms of section 56 of the Aliens Control Act, 1991 (Act No. 96 of 1991), made the regulations in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE**Definition**

1. In these regulations "the Regulations" means the Aliens Control Regulations (Fees), published under Government Notice No. R1000 of 28 June 1996.

Substitution of regulation 2 of the Regulations

2. The following regulation is hereby substituted for regulation 2 of the Regulations:

2. The fees which may be charged in respect of the application for permits, certificates and visas issued in terms of the provisions of the Act, are set out in the following Annexure:

3. These regulations shall be called the Sixth Amendment of the Aliens Control Regulations (Fees), 1999, and shall come into operation on 1 April 1999.
