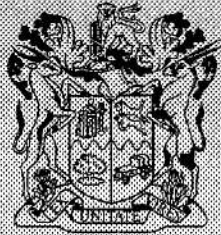

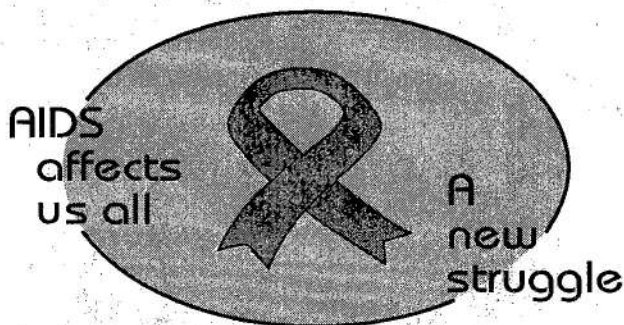

ALIENS CONTROL ACT, 1991 (ACT NO 96 OF 1991)

SEVENTH AMENDMENT OF THE ALIENS CONTROL REGULATIONS (FEES)

The Minister of Home Affairs has, in terms of section 56 of the Aliens Control Act, 1991 (Act No 96 of 1991), made the regulations in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Definition

1. In these regulations "the Regulations" means the Aliens Control Regulations (Fees), published under Government Notice No. R1000 of 28 June 1996.

Substitution of regulation 2 of the Regulations

"Fees"

2. The fees which may be charged in respect of applications for permits, certificates and visas issued in terms of the provisions of the Act, are set out in the following Annexure:

* "The local tariff is applicable when the service is rendered in the Republic of South Africa, whilst the foreign tariff (if not the United States dollar, then the corresponding amount in the local currency) is applicable for services rendered outside the Republic of South Africa at missions. The Rand/US Dollar exchange rate is calculated at \$1 = R6,00 and is stipulated so as to avoid the daily recalculation of fluctuating foreign exchange rates".		

Short title

3. These regulations shall be called the Seventh Amendment of the Aliens Control Regulations (Fees), 1999, and shall come into operation on 20 December 1999.
