SCHEDULE**Definitions**

1. In this schedule the Regulations shall mean the Aliens Control Regulations (Fees), published under Government Notice R276 of 1 April 2000.

Substitution of regulation (2) of the regulations

2. The following regulation is hereby substituted for regulation 2 of the Regulations:

3. The fees which may be charged in respect of the application for permits, certificates and visas issued in terms of the provision of the Act, are set out in the following Annexure:

IDENTIFICATION ACT, 1997 (ACT 68 OF 1997)**FOURTH AMENDMENT OF THE REGULATIONS IN TERMS OF IDENTIFICATION ACT, 1997**

The Minister of Home Affairs has, under section 22 of Identification Act, 1997 (Act No. 68 of 1997), made the regulations set out in the schedule.

SCHEDULE**DEFINITIONS**

1. In these regulations "The Regulations" means the Regulations in terms of Identification Act, 1997, published under Government Notice No. R978 of 31 July 1998, as amended by Government Notice No. R1014 of 7 August 1998 as well as Government Notice R275 of 1 April 2000.

Substitution of regulation 15 of the Regulation

2. The following fees are payable in the respective cases:
 - (a) Identity document: Re-issuing: R10-00 provided that the re-issuing of identity document is free of charge in those cases where an identity document was issued and the forename is repeated as a surname in the document, if the Department did not insist on the application for insertion of the surname at the time of the initial application, and when a new identity document is issued to a former TBVC citizen to replace his old South African identity document classifying him/her as a non-South African citizen.
 - (b) Issuing of a Temporary Identity Certificate (TIC): R8-00.
 - (c) The furnishing of information from Population Register on magnetic tape or similar format in accordance with the provisions of section 21 of the Identification Act, 1997 (Act 68 of 1997): R205-00 request for every 5 000 persons or for portion thereof.

- (d) Direct access to the Department's computer system for information from the population register by private institutions, bodies, organisations, or societies, in accordance with section 21 of the Identification Act, 1997 (Act 68 of 1997): R335-00 pm per consumer plus R 0,60c per transaction.
- (e) Frame of four black and white photos taken for ID applications: R10-00.

Short title and commencement

3. These regulations shall be called Fourth Amendment of the Regulations in terms of Identification Act, 1997 and shall come into operation on 1 April 2001.
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
