REGULATIONS UNDER THE MEDICINES AND RELATED SUBSTANCES CONTROL ACT, 1965 (ACT No. 101 OF 1965): AMENDMENT

The Minister of Health has, in terms of section 35 of the Medicines and Related Substances Control Act, 1965 (Act No. 101 of 1965), on the recommendation of the Medicines Control Council, made the regulations contained in the Schedule hereto.

NOTICE OF EXEMPTION IN TERMS OF SECTION 40 (1) OF THE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT, 1993

Under section 40 (3) (b) of the Occupational Health and Safety Act, 1993 (Act No. 85 of 1993), I, Moses Pudikabekwa, appointed as chief inspector in terms of section 27 (1) of the said Act, and by virtue of the power delegated to me by the Minister of Labour in terms of section 42 (1) of the Act, hereby grant exemption in terms of section 40 (1) until 1 June 2003 to all test stations that are registered under the incorporated health and safety standard South African Bureau of Standard 019:1985 under regulation 10 of the Vessels under Pressure Regulations, published under *Government Gazette* Notice No. R. 1591 of 4 October 1996.

This exemption is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. All test stations shall obtain accreditation before approval from the government endorsed national accreditation body, the "South African National Accreditation System"; and
- 2. the accreditation in terms of clause 7.2.2 of the South African Bureau of Standard 019 as amended, as incorporated under regulation 10 of the Vessels under Pressure Regulations, shall be in terms of-
 - (a) ISO 17020 "General criteria for the operation of various types of bodies performing inspection"; and
 - (b) SABS 1825 "Portable gas cylinder test stations-approval and general requirements".

AMENDMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS, 2001

The Minister for the Public Service and Administration has, under section 41 of the Public Service Act, 1994 (promulgated under Proclamation No. 103 of 1994), amended the Public Service Regulations, 2001 (promulgated under Government Notice R. 1 of 5 January 2001), as amended, as set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

The following regulations are hereby substituted for regulations III J.3 and J.4 of Chapter 1:

- "J.3 From 1 April 2001, the annual report shall include such information on planning, service delivery, organisation, job evaluation, remuneration, benefits, personnel expenditure, the utilisation of consultants, affirmative action, recruitment, promotions, termination of services, performance management, skills development, injury on duty, labour relations, leave and discharge due to ill-health, as the Minister determines. In this regulation 'consultant' means a natural or juristic person or a partnership who or which provides in terms of a specific contract on an ad hoc basis any of the following professional services to a department against remuneration received from any source:
 - (a) The rendering of expert advice;
 - (b) the drafting of proposals for the execution of specific tasks; and
 - (c) the executing of a specific task which is of a technical or intellectual nature,
 - but excludes an employee of a department.
- J.4 The Minister shall determine from time to time the format in which the information referred to in regulation III J.3 is to be included in the annual report.".
