Government Printing Works has implemented rules for completing and submitting the electronic Adobe Forms when you, the customer, submits your notice request.

Please take note of these guidelines when completing your form.



GPW Business Rules

1. No hand written notices will be accepted for processing, this includes Adobe forms which have been completed by hand.
2. Notices can only be submitted in Adobe electronic form format to the email submission address submit.egazette@gpw.gov.za. This means that any notice submissions not on an Adobe electronic form that are submitted to this mailbox will be **rejected**. National or Provincial gazette notices, where the Z95 or Z95Prov must be an Adobe form but the notice content (body) will be an attachment.
3. Notices brought into GPW by "walk-in" customers on electronic media can only be submitted in Adobe electronic form format. This means that any notice submissions not on an Adobe electronic form that are submitted by the customer on electronic media will be **rejected**. National or Provincial gazette notices, where the Z95 or Z95Prov must be an Adobe form but the notice content (body) will be an attachment.
4. All customers who walk in to GPW that wish to submit a notice that is not on an electronic Adobe form will be routed to the Contact Centre where the customer will be taken through the completion of the form by a GPW representative. Where a customer walks into GPW with a stack of hard copy notices delivered by a messenger on behalf of a newspaper the messenger must be referred back to the sender as the submission does not adhere to the submission rules.
5. All notice submissions that do not comply with point 2 will be charged full price for the notice submission.
6. The current cut-off of all Gazette's remains unchanged for all channels. (Refer to the GPW website for submission deadlines – www.gpwonline.co.za)
7. Incorrectly completed forms and notices submitted in the wrong format will be rejected to the customer to be corrected and resubmitted. Assistance will be available through the Contact Centre should help be required when completing the forms. (012-748 6200 or email info.egazette@gpw.gov.za)
8. All re-submissions by customers will be subject to the above cut-off times.
9. All submissions and re-submissions that miss the cut-off will be rejected to the customer to be submitted with a new publication date.
10. Information on forms will be taken as the primary source of the notice to be published. Any instructions that are on the email body or covering letter that contradicts the notice form content will be ignored.

You are therefore advised that effective from **Monday, 18 May 2015** should you not comply with our new rules of engagement, all notice requests will be rejected by our new system.

Furthermore, the fax number **012- 748 6030** will also be **discontinued** from this date and customers will only be able to submit notice requests through the email address submit.egazette@gpw.gov.za.

WINE OF ORIGIN SCHEME: AMENDMENT

I, Senzeni Zokwana, Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, acting under section 14 of the Liquor Products Act, 1989 (Act No. 60 of 1989), on the recommendation of the Wine and Spirit Board referred to in section 2 of said Act, hereby amend the Wine of Origin Scheme published by Government Notice No. R. 1434 of 1990, as amended, to the extent set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Definition

1. In this Schedule "the Scheme" means the Wine of Origin Scheme published by Government Notice No. R. 1434 of 29 June 1990, as amended by Government Notices No's R. 837 of 19 April 1991, R. 2842 of 29 November 1991, R.1054 of 10 April 1992, R. 2594 of 11 September 1992, R. 3231 of 27 November 1992, R. 546 of 2 April 1993, R. 1375 of 30 July 1993, R. 1021 of 27 May 1994, R. 2067 of 2 December 1994, R. 814 of 9 June 1995, R. 1875 of 8 December 1995, R. 1039 of 8 August 1997, R 834 of 26 June 1998, R 324 of 19 March 1999, R. 19 of 12 January 2001, R. 829 of 21 June 2002, R. 1306 of 25 October 2002 as corrected by R. 1503 of 6 December 2002, R.1819 of 19 December 2003, R. 835 of 26 August 2005, R. 813 of 11 August 2006, R. 554 of 22 May 2009, R. 526 of 13 July 2012 and R. 403 of 2 May 2014.

Substitution of section 4 of the Scheme

2. The following section is hereby substituted for section 4 of the Scheme:

"Liquor Product to which Scheme applies

4. (1) This Scheme shall apply to wine produced from grapes of the vine cultivars specified in Table 1 or 2.

- (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1), the board may on application determine that the Scheme shall also apply to wine produced from grapes of a vine cultivar not specified in Table 1 or 2 subject to such conditions and for such period as the board may determine."

Amendment of section 7 of the Scheme

3. Section 7 of the Scheme is hereby amended by the substitution for subsection (2) of the following subsection:

"(2) The provisions of subsection (1)(c), (d) and (f) shall not apply to wine intended for export in bulk."

Amendment of Table 1 of the Scheme

4. Table 1 of the Scheme is hereby amended –
- (a) by the substitution for the entry "Palomino (Fransdruiif; White French)" of the entry "Palomino (Fransdruiif; White French; Malvasia Rei)";
 - (b) by the insertion in the alphabetically correct places of the entries "Carmenere", "Grenache Gris" and "Nero D'Avola".

Amendment of Table 2 of the Scheme

5. Table 2 of the Scheme is hereby amended by the insertion in the alphabetically correct places of the entries "Carmenere" and "Grenache Gris".

Amendment of Table 4 of the Scheme

6. Table 4 of the Scheme is hereby amended –
- (a) by the substitution for every paragraph (d) in column 3, of the following paragraph:
"(d) Volatile character (such as vinegar and ethyl acetate)";
 - (b) by the substitution for every paragraph (l) in column 3, of the following paragraph:
"(l) Foreign to wine character (such as geranium, oil, paint)";
 - (c) by the substitution for every paragraph (m) in column 3, of the following paragraph:
"(m) Microbiological decay (such as "Brettanomyces", vinegar and mouse)".

REGULATIONS: AMENDMENT

The Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries has, under section 27 of the Liquor Products Act, 1989 (Act No. 60 of 1989), made the regulations in the Schedule.

SCHEDULEDefinition

Amendment of regulation 31 of the Regulations

2. Regulation 31 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (h) of subregulation (4) of the following paragraph:

"(h) Control by the administering officer of the liquor product concerned shall be lifted if a certificate by an analyst confirms that the liquor product concerned contains no more than 0.1 milligram per litre of simple and complex cyanides and cyanates expressed as hydrocyanic acid."

Amendment of regulation 39A of the Regulations

3. Regulation 39A of the Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion after subregulation (5) of the following subregulations:

"(6) Subject to the provisions of subregulations (3), (4), (5) and (7), the provisions of section 11(2)(d) of the Act shall not be construed as restricting the use, in connection with the sale of wine, of a class designation or any word or expression resembling a class designation, if used in or as part of general descriptive terms.

- (7) The exemption from the restriction on the use of a class designation in connection with the sale of wine as referred to in subregulation (6), shall be subject to such use which in the opinion of the administering officer or the board, as the case may be, does not -
- (a) constitute a contravention of section 12 of the Act;
 - (b) convey or create or is likely to convey or create an impression that the wine concerned is of a class specified in Table 2; or
 - (c) qualify the certification of the wine concerned or is contrary to such certification."

- (a) by the substitution for the entry "Palomino (Fransdruif; White French)" of the entry "Palomino (Fransdruif; White French; Malvasia Rei)";
- (b) by the insertion in the alphabetically correct places of the entries "Carmenere", "Grenache Gris" and "Nero D'Avola".

5. Table 2 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion in the numerically correct places of the following entries:

The product shall be anywhere from light golden, to deep golden, to amber in colour. 8. The product shall be certified and sold as a vintage wine.
8c. Natural pale/Non-fortified pale	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The product shall not contain added spirit. 2. The product shall be produced from white grape cultivars. 3. The product shall be matured in oaken casks, under a film of flor yeast, for at least 2 years. 4. The alcohol content of the product shall be at least 12,0 per cent, but not more than 15,0 per cent. 5. The sulphur dioxide content of the product shall not exceed 40,0 milligram per litre. 6. The product shall complete malolactic fermentation. 7. The product shall have a delicate flavour suggestive of almonds. 8. The product shall have a discernible flor yeast and wood character. 9. The product shall be anywhere from pale, to straw, to pale-golden in colour.

	10. The product may only be sold if it has been certified.
8d. Methode ancestrale	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The product shall be made from fermenting must. 2. Further fermentation shall occur solely in the bottle in which the product is to be sold. 3. No sweetening agent shall be added to the product. 4. The pressure in the bottle in which the product is sold shall be at least 75 kPa. 6. The product may only be sold if it has been certified.

Wysiging van regulasie 39A van die Regulasies

3. Regulasie 39A van die Regulasies word hierby gewysig deur die volgende subregulasie na subregulasie (5) in te voeg:

"(6) Behoudens die bepalings van subregulasies (3), (4), (5) en (7), word die bepalings van artikel 11(2)(d) van die Wet nie so uitgelê nie as sou dit 'n beperking plaas op die gebruik, in verband met die verkoop van wyn, van 'n klasbenaming of enige woord of uitdrukking wat trek na 'n klasbenaming, indien in of as deel van algemene beskrywende terme gebruik word.

- (7) Die vrystelling van die beperking op die gebruik in verband met die verkoop van wyn van 'n klasbenaming in subregulasie (6) bedoel, is onderhewig daaraan dat sodanige gebruik, na die oordeel van die beherende amptenaar of die raad, na gelang van die geval, nie -
- (a) 'n oortreding van artikel 12 van die Wet daarstel nie;
 - (b) 'n indruk weergee of skep of waarskynlik kan weergee of skep dat die betrokke wyn van 'n klas in Tabel 2 vermeld, is nie; of
 - (c) die sertifisering van die betrokke wyn kwalifiseer of in stryd met sodanige sertifisering is nie."

National or Provincial gazette notices, where the Z95 or Z95Prov must be an Adobe form but the notice content (body) will be an attachment.
4. All customers who walk in to GPW that wish to submit a notice that is not on an electronic Adobe form will be routed to the Contact Centre where the customer will be taken through the completion of the form by a GPW representative. Where a customer walks into GPW with a stack of hard copy notices delivered by a messenger on behalf of a newspaper the messenger must be referred back to the sender as the submission does not adhere to the submission rules.
5. All notice submissions that do not comply with point 2 will be charged full price for the notice submission.
6. The current cut-off of all Gazette's remains unchanged for all channels. (Refer to the GPW website for submission deadlines – www.gpwonline.co.za)
7. Incorrectly completed forms and notices submitted in the wrong format will be rejected to the customer to be corrected and resubmitted. Assistance will be available through the Contact Centre should help be required when completing the forms. (012-748 6200 or email info.egazette@gpw.gov.za)
8. All re-submissions by customers will be subject to the above cut-off times.
9. All submissions and re-submissions that miss the cut-off will be rejected to the customer to be submitted with a new publication date.
10. Information on forms will be taken as the primary source of the notice to be published. Any instructions that are on the email body or covering letter that contradicts the notice form content will be ignored.

You are therefore advised that effective from **Monday, 18 May 2015** should you not comply with our new rules of engagement, all notice requests will be rejected by our new system.
