BASIC CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT ACT, NO 75 OF 1997 CORRECTION NOTICE

SECTORAL DETERMINATION 6: PRIVATE SECURITY SECTOR, SOUTH AFRICA.

I, Thembelani Thulas Nxesi, Minister of Employment and Labour, hereby in terms of section 56(3) (b) of the Basic Conditions of Employment Act, No 75 of 1997, effect corrections to the Sectoral Determination 6: Private Security Sector, South Africa, published under Government Gazette No. 39156 of 1st September 2015, as per attached schedule.

SCHEDULE

- 1. Delete the phrase 'one and one and half' in clause 8(1) to read as follows:
 - (1) An employer must pay an employee who works on a Sunday at double the employee's salary for each hour worked, unless the employee ordinarily works on a Sunday, in which case the employer must pay the employee at one and one-half times the employee's salary for each hour worked.
