NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE NATIONAL AGRICULTURAL MARKETING COUNCIL

The Minister of Agriculture, Land Reform and Rural Development hereby invites persons and interested parties to submit to her names of nominees to be considered for appointment as members of the National Agricultural Marketing Council (NAMC). The NAMC is a statutory body established in terms of Section 3 of the Marketing of Agricultural Products Act, 1996 (Act No. 47 of 1996) (MAP Act).

The nominees will be considered for appointment by virtue of their practical knowledge and experience of one or more of the following:

- (a) The commercial production of agricultural products
- (b) Agricultural product-related trade and industry
- (c) Agricultural economics, including agricultural marketing and international agricultural trade
- (d) Consumer issues relating to agricultural products, including issues relating to previously disadvantaged communities
- (e) The production and marketing of agricultural products by small-scale and previously disadvantaged farmers.

Members of the council will be appointed for a period not exceeding four years. Each nomination must be accompanied by the following:

- A detailed Curriculum Vitae
- A written acceptance of the nomination by the nominee
- An indication of the category the nominee would like to be considered for
- Certified copies of all qualifications
- Certified copy of ID document.

Successful candidates will be subject to a personnel suitability check regarding citizenship, criminal record and qualification verification.

A person may not be nominated or appointed as a council member if such person has been disqualified to serve as a council member in terms of section 4(13) of the Act.
