DISASTER MANAGEMENT ACT, 2002**EXTENSION OF A NATIONAL STATE OF DISASTER (COVID-19)**

I, the Minister of Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs, as designated under section 3 of the Disaster Management Act, 2002 (Act No. 57 of 2002) ("the Act"), in terms of section 27(5)(c) of the Act, hereby further extend the national state of disaster that I extended to 15 January 2021 by Government Notice 1341, published in Government Gazette 43993, to 15 February 2021, taking into account the need to continue augmenting the existing legislation and contingency arrangements undertaken by organs of state to address the impact of the disaster.
