PROCLAMATIONS

BY LIEUTENANT-COLONEL HIS EXCELLENCY THE RIGHT HONOURABLE THE EARL OF CLARENDON, A MEMBER OF HIS MAJESTY'S MOST HONOURABLE PRIVY COUNCIL, KNIGHT GRAND CROSS OF THE MOST DISTINGUISHED ORDER OF SAINT MICHAEL AND SAINT GEORGE, GOVERNOR-GENERAL AND COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF IN AND OVER THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA.

Whereas by Proclamation No. 36 of 1918, dated the 22nd March, 1918, and published in the *Union Government Gazette* of the 28th March, 1918, certain portions of the farm Borrels Kopje, H.V. 45, Division of Barkly West, Mining District of Barkly West, Province of the Cape of Good Hope, was proclaimed an alluvial digging for precious stones, in accordance with section twenty-seven of the Precious Stones Act, 1899 (Act No. 11 of 1899 of the Cape of Good Hope), under the name of „Borrels Kopje”;

And whereas by Proclamations Nos. 71 of 1928, dated the 17th March, 1928, and 231 of 1928, dated 3rd October, 1928, published in the *Union Government Gazette* of the 30th March, 1928, and the 12th October, 1928, respectively, portions of the said farm Borrels Kopje were withdrawn from the operation of Proclamation No. 36 of 1918.

And whereas it has now been found expedient to close and deproclaim as an alluvial digging for precious stones a further portion of the said farm;

'n Vaste bedrag van 12s. per Boedel word bereken vir die publikasie in skedulevorm van kennisgewings voorgeskrewe deur die Regulasies opgestel volgens die Insolvensiewet, 1916.

In die geval van vorms 3 en 4, moet adverteerders die woorde in die advertensies tel en reken: 12s. vir die eerste 36 woorde (of gedeelte daarvan) en 2s. vir elke addisionele 12 woorde (of gedeelte daarvan).
