PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the High Commissioner.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Administration of Estates Proclamation, 1933 (No. 33 of 1933) (hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation") to provide for the powers and duties of an Assistant Master.

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section two of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the addition after the definition of "Master" of the following new definition:—

" 'Assistant Master' shall mean any official appointed by the High Commissioner to act for and perform the duties of the Master of the Court of the Resident Commissioner of the Territory in the absence of the said Master."

2. Section six of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the addition of the following new sub-section to be numbered (2), the present sub-section (2) being renumbered (3):—

" (2) In the absence of the Master all the powers and rights exercisable and all duties to be performed by him may be exercised and performed by an Assistant Master who shall be appointed by the High Commissioner."

3. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Administration of Estates (Amendment) Proclamation 1935 and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
