PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Whereas it is desirable to authorize the transfer of the title, rights, powers and privileges conferred in certain Proclamations for the construction, maintenance and working of the line of railway within the Bechuanaland Protectorate;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. This Proclamation may be cited for all purposes as "Railways Transfer of Statutory Powers Proclamation, 1935", and shall come into force on a date to be fixed by the High Commissioner by notice in the *Gazette*.

2. "The Company" means The Rhodesia Railways, Limited, formerly known as the Bechuanaland Railway Company, Limited.

"The undertakings" means the undertakings as defined in the Railway Proclamation, 1935 (No. 37 of 1935).

3. The Company is hereby empowered, in any sale, transfer or assignment approved by the High Commissioner of the undertakings or any portion of such undertakings as part of any scheme for the redemption, conversion or consolidation of the debenture debt of the Company, to sell, transfer or assign the title, rights, powers and privileges conferred upon the Company in the enactments set out in the Schedule to this Proclamation or such of them as relate to the portion of the undertakings so sold, transferred or assigned and thereupon the successors or assigns of the Company shall be vested with the said title, rights, powers and privileges of the Company in as full and ample a manner as if they had been conferred upon them by the said enactments and shall be subject to the obligations and conditions placed upon the Company in the said enactments.

4. Nothing in this Proclamation shall be deemed in any way to withdraw from the operation of the Railway Proclamation, 1935, the undertakings or any portion thereof.
