PROCLAMATION

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bechuanaland Protectorate Purchase of Produce Licences Proclamation, 1932 (No. 18 of 1932), hereinafter referred to as the said Proclamation;

Now therefore under and by virtue of the powers in me vested I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Section one of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by repealing the definition of "produce" and by substituting the following new definition:—

" 'Produce' shall mean hides, grain, the skins of any wild or domestic animal, and poultry, including domestic fowls, ducks, pigeons and turkeys and the eggs thereof."

2. This Proclamation may be cited as the Bechuanaland Protectorate Purchase of Produce Licences Amendment Proclamation 1936 and shall have force and take effect from the first day of July, 1936.

It is hereby notified for general information that, under the power vested in me by sub-section (1) of section ten of the Motor-Car (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation,

1929 (No. 10 of 1929), I have been pleased to fix the rate of speed, which may not be exceeded by any person driving any motor-car as in that Proclamation defined, at 15 miles an hour over the following portion of the public road at Lobatsi, viz.:—

From a point where the Mafeking-Lobatsi road enters the village of Lobatsi where such road joins the road crossing the railway line, to the drift in the river on the Zeerust road, and from the first-mentioned point to the corner where the Mafeking-Lobatsi road turns north-west towards the Athlone Hospital, at which places sign-posts marked "speed 15 miles" are erected.

Any person who drives a motor vehicle upon such portions of the aforesaid roads at a speed exceeding the rate prescribed will be guilty of an offence and liable to the penalties provided in the aforementioned Proclamation.
