DUMPING DUTY ON METAL MANUFACTURES.

Whereas by section fifteen of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Act, 1925 (Act No. 36 of 1925), as amended, whenever after investigation and report by the Board of Trade and Industries the Minister of Finance—

(a) is satisfied that goods which are of a class or kind produced or manufactured in the Union have been or are being exported to the Union at an export price which is less than the domestic value plus the extra cost of packing and packages for export, carriage to port of shipment, and all other expenses incidental to placing the goods on board ship ready for export to the Union; and

(b) is of opinion that detriment from that cause may result to an industry in the Union and that it would be in the public interest to impose in respect of such goods a dumping duty,

the Governor-General may by proclamation in the *Gazette* notify the class of goods and declare that one or more of the dumping duties enumerated in sub-section (2) of the said section, and set forth in such proclamation shall be levied upon goods of such class on importation into the Union from a country or countries named in the proclamation.

And whereas in consequence of investigation and report by the Board of Trade and Industries the Minister of Finance is satisfied that black steel plates and/or sheets of a class or kind produced or manufactured in the Union have been or are being exported to the Union from the United States of America at export prices which are less than the domestic value thereof plus the extra cost of packing and packages for export, carriage to port of shipment and other expenses, incidental to placing the black steel plates and/or sheets referred to on board ship ready for export to the Union, and is further of opinion that detriment does result from such cause to the Iron and Steel Manufacturing Industry in the Union by such importation, and that it is in the public interest to impose an "ordinary" dumping duty on such black steel plates and/or sheets from the United States of America.

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me as aforesaid, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known that from and after the date of the publication of this my Proclamation in the *Gazette* there shall be charged, levied, collected and paid on all black steel plates and/or sheets, except those exceeding 4 feet by 12 feet by $\frac{3}{16}$ of an inch in any one dimension, on importation into the Union from the United States of America an "ordinary" dumping duty equal to the difference between the "export price" as defined in section nineteen of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Act, 1925 (Act No. 36 of 1925), as amended, and the "domestic value" thereof as defined in that section, plus the extra cost of packing and packages for export, carriage to port of shipment and all other expenses incidental to placing such goods on board ship ready for export to the Union, provided—

(a) that such difference is greater than five per centum of the export price, and

(b) that such duty shall not exceed one-half of the value for duty purposes of the black steel plates and/or sheets referred to above, as defined in section fourteen of the Customs Tariff and Excise Duties Amendment Act, 1925 (Act No. 36 of 1925), as amended, and

(c) that such dumping duty shall not be imposed in respect of such black steel plates and/or sheets shipped to the Union from the United States of America prior to the date of publication of this my Proclamation in the *Gazette*.

AMENDMENT OF PRISON REGULATION No. 417.

His Excellency the Governor-General-in-Council has been pleased, by virtue of the powers in him vested by section *eighty-eight* of the Prisons and Reformatories Act, No. 13 of 1911, to approve of the cancellation of Prison Regulation No. 417, and the substitution therefor of the following amended regulation:—

417. (a) For the purposes of these regulations, a recidivist shall mean any person who, having at any time served a sentence of imprisonment in a gaol or prison or of detention in a farm colony, is thereafter sentenced to such imprisonment or detention in respect of an offence committed subsequent to the date of the first-mentioned sentence; provided that a sentence of imprisonment for the contravention of the pass law, a statutory regulation or municipal by-law shall not be taken into account unless the period of imprisonment exceeds one month.

(b) Any first offender who has been sentenced to such imprisonment or detention for a period of more than two years shall, except for purposes of remission of sentence, be treated as a recidivist.

Except in cases where exemption is granted by the Inspector of Apprenticeship, apprentices shall, in respect of the periods specified below, undergo training as indicated:—

First six months of Apprenticeship.—Plaster work, removing cases from flasks, cleaning, etc. Sandpapering and preparing dentures for polishing. Bite block making. Making of base plates in composition, tin and other materials and special trays in metal or compounds. Preparation of materials in use in work room and care of equipment of workroom.

Second six months of Apprenticeship.—Modelling and carving in plaster, soap or wax. Simple repairs and additions. Die-making in zinc, tin, lead, etc. Uses and principles of various articulators. Waxing up dentures for trial and flasking. Flasking and packing simple partial dentures and repairs. Polishing dentures. Inlay casting.

Second year of Apprenticeship.—To be spent in gaining proficiency in processes learnt during the first and second six months of apprenticeship.

Third year of Apprenticeship.—Crown making—all metal—Richmond and other types. Simple soldering, casting and general principles involved in Dental Metallurgy. Principles and elementary chemistry of Thermo plastic and other denture materials: Flasking and pressing of these materials. Setting up dentures of all types.

Fourth year of Apprenticeship.—Gum sections; metal plate swaging. Fitting tube teeth, soldering of facings and gilding.

Fifth year of Apprenticeship.—Gaining proficiency in all branches of work and getting to understand the principles of obturators, splints and orthodontic appliances.

SCHEDULE.

- "bedding" means all kinds of mattresses, including woven wire, spiral, chain and spring mattresses, overlays, pillows, bolsters and cushions, but excluding top-stuffed inner spiral spring, and box spring mattresses;
- "employment" means the total length of all periods of any person's employment in the furniture industry;

- "learner packer" means a packer who has had less than two years' experience of packing furniture in the furniture industry, and who works under the supervision of a packer;
- "machinery maintenance mechanic" means a person who is employed in tracing faults in, overhauling or repairing machinery or mechanically propelled vehicles used in or in connection with an establishment or in supervising all or any of these operations;
- "upholsterer" means a person engaged in webbing, springing, stuffing and covering all chairs and loose seats, settees, box ottomans, top stuffed inner spiral spring box spring mattresses and pouffes; doing any button work on chairs, etc., cutting out all covers, fitting of covers, cutting and fitting loose covers, making of pelmets and curtains; joining carpets, and cutting of fancy cushions and eiderdown quilts;
- "seamster" means a person engaged in sewing and joining of all covers required by the upholsterer, sewing flies, cushions, fancy cushions, pillows, mattress cases, cords, curtains, pelmets, bolsters, loose covers and eiderdowns.

MALARIA.

Natal and Zululand.—Very heavy rains have fallen throughout the Province, thereby creating numerous seepage areas. Owing, however, to the low temperatures prevailing, no increase of *A. Gambiae* breeding is anticipated.

Active breeding of *A. Gambiae* is still occurring in certain coastal areas, more particularly north of the Tugela River. Adult *A. Gambiae* continue to be found in habitations in the neighbourhood of breeding foci, particularly in the Tugela, Umhlatuzi, Umfolosi and Umkuzi valleys in the Nkandhla, Mahlabatini, Nongoma and Ngotshe Districts. A few fresh malaria infections still continue to be reported.

Transvaal.—During the past week severe cold was experienced, the minimum temperature being below 40 degrees throughout the week. Frost was reported in various parts of the district. New infections are becoming very infrequent because of the marked decrease in the mosquito vectors entering human habitations.

There is a slight increase in the relapse rate.

Daar is egter nog 'n bedrywige uitbroeiing van hierdie soort muskiet in sekere kusstreke, vernaamlik noord van die Toegela-rivier. Volwasse *Gambiae*-muskiete word nog steeds aangetref in wonings in die nabyheid van uitbroei-plekke, vernaamlik in die valleie van die Toegela, Oemhlatoesi, Oemfolosi en Oemkoezi in die distrikte Nkandhla, Mahlabatini, Nongoma en Ngotshe. Enkele nuwe malariabesmettings word nog steeds gerapporteer.

Transvaal.—Gedurende die afgelope week is strawwe koue ondervind, die laagste temperatuur was benede 40 grade gedurende die hele week. Ryp in verskillende dele is gerapporteer. Nuwe besmettings kom nou baie selde voor as gevolg van die merkbare vermindering van die muskietvektor wat die woonplekke van die mense binnedring.

Aanmanings van malaria is 'n weinig aan vermeerder.
