In terms of sub-section (1) of section twenty-nine of the Marketing Act, 1937 (Act No. 26 of 1937), I, WILLIAM RICHARD COLLINS, Minister of Agriculture and Forestry, hereby notify that the Wheat Industry Control Board referred to in section two of the Wheat Control Scheme, published under Proclamation No. 212 in the *Government Gazette* No. 2574, of the 5th October, 1938, has, in terms of section twenty-three of that Scheme, and with my approval, prohibited any person who grinds, crushes, grists or otherwise processes wheat from selling meal or flour of the various grades at prices other than the prices specified in the Schedule below or bran and pollard at a price above the price specified in the Schedule below.

And I do hereby notify that the said prohibition shall become operative from date of publication hereof.

SELLING PRICES OF MEAL AND FLOUR, BRAN AND POLLARD.

(Fixed by the Wheat Industry Control Board, in terms of Section 23 of the Wheat Control Scheme.)

I. MEAL AND FLOUR.

(a) Selling prices to bakers for use in their bakeries only or to wholesalers who confine their business exclusively to supplying retailers and who take not less than 25 bags of meal or flour of 200 lb. each at a time:—

Best Bakers' Flour: 37s. 3d. per bag of 200 lb. net.
No. 1 Sifted Meal: 34s. 6d. per bag of 200 lb. net.

No. 1 or Best Unsifted Meal: 29s. per bag of 200 lb. net.

VERKOOPPRYSE VAN MEEL EN MEELBLOM, SEMELS EN FYNSEMELS.

(Vasgestel deur die Raad van Beheer oor die Koringnywerheid, kragtens Artikel 23 van die Koringreëlingskema.)

I. MEEL EN MEELBLOM.

(a) Verkoopprysse aan bakkers slegs vir gebruik in hulle bakkerye of aan groothandelaars wat uitsluitlik aan kleinhandelaars lewer, en wat nie minder as 25 sakke meel of meelblom van 200 pond elk tegelyk neem nie:—

Best Bakkersmeelblom: 37s. 3d. per sak van 200 pond netto.

No. 1 Gesifte Meel: 34s. 6d. per sak van 200 pond netto.

No. 1 of Beste Ongesifte Meel: 29s. per sak van 200 pond netto.

(b) Selling prices to retailers or to wholesalers who take less than 25 bags of meal or flour of 200 lb. each at a time:—

Best Bakers' Flour: 38s. 3d. per bag of 200 lb. net.
No. 1 Sifted Meal: 35s. 6d. per bag of 200 lb. net.
No. 1 or Best Unsifted Meal: 30s. per bag of 200 lb. net.

The prices specified in paragraphs (a) and (b) are for meal and flour delivered carriage paid to the retailer's or wholesaler's nearest station; provided that any road motor bus charges shall be paid by the baker or wholesaler (as the case may be).

II. BRAN AND POLLARD.

Selling prices (maximum) to the trade generally:—

Bran and Pollard: 5s. 6d. per bag of 100 lb. net.

The above price is for bran and pollard delivered free on rail at the station or siding of the person who has ground, crushed, gristed or otherwise processed the wheat of which the bran or pollard is a product.

And I do hereby notify that the said prohibition shall become operative from date of publication hereof.

SELLING PRICES OF BREAD.

(Fixed by the Wheat Industry Control Board, in terms of Section 23 of the Wheat Control Scheme.)

I. RETAIL PRICES.

- (a) The standard size, unwrapped 2 lb. loaf made of best bakers flour whether delivered to the customer or sold over the counter, per loaf: 7d.
- (b) The 2 lb. brown unwrapped loaf, whether delivered to the customer or sold over the counter, per loaf: 7d.
- (c) The standard size, 2 lb. loaf of second grade bread, sold over the counter, per loaf: 6d.

II. WHOLESALE PRICES.

The wholesale prices for the three grades of bread referred to in Section I of this Schedule shall be the retail prices fixed for the respective grades, less a discount of ten per cent.

In terms of sub-section (1) of section twenty-nine of the Marketing Act, 1937 (Act No. 26 of 1937), I, WILLIAM RICHARD COLLINS, Minister of Agriculture and Forestry, hereby notify that the Wheat Industry Control Board referred to in section two of the Wheat Control Scheme, published under Proclamation No. 212 in the *Government Gazette* No. 2574, of the 5th October, 1938, has, in terms of section twenty-three of that Scheme, and with my approval, prohibited any producer of wheat from selling wheat of the various classes and grades at prices other than the prices specified in the Schedule below; provided that this prohibition shall not apply to wheat sold for seed purposes by producers of wheat to whom the board has issued in terms of sub-section (3) of section twenty-two of the Scheme a permit for the sale of wheat for seed purposes.

And I do hereby notify that the said prohibition shall become operative from date of publication hereof, and shall remain in force until the 31st day of October, 1939.

- (a) The producer shall sell wheat at the above prices less a commission of 9d. (ninepence) per bag which shall be deducted by the Board or an agent of the Board appointed in terms of sub-section (2) of section twenty-two of the Scheme.
- (b) The above prices are for wheat delivered free on rail producer's railway station (any road motor service charges are to be paid by the producer).
- (c) The above prices apply only to wheat delivered in new $2\frac{1}{2}$ lb. A twill bags.

II. WHEAT DELIVERED IN ELEVATORS.

The producer shall sell wheat delivered in elevators at the prices scheduled in Section I above per unit of 200 lb. net, less 6d. (sixpence) per unit and less the commission, 9d. (ninepence) per unit referred to in paragraph (a) of Section I of this Schedule.
