

KENNISGEWING INGEVOLGE REGULASIE 3 VAN DIE AANHANGSEL VAN PROKLAMASIE NO. 201 VAN 1939, SOOS GEWYSIG BY PROKLAMASIE NO. 135 VAN 1941.

Ek, RICHARD STUTTAFORD, Minister van Handel en Nywerheid, handelende kragtens regulasie 3, soos gewysig by Proklamasie No. 135 van 1941, van die Landsnoodtoestand-regulasies uiteengesit in die Aanhangsel van Proklamasie No. 201 van 1939, soos bekragtig by artikel twee van die Wet op Oorlogsmatreëls, 1940 (Wet No. 18 van 1940), en op aanbeveling van die Raad van Beheer van Landsvoorrade, herroep hierby artikel (a) van Goewermentskennisgewing No. 1095 gedateerd 1 Augustus 1941, en stel die volgende nuwe artikel (a) in die plek daarvan:—

(a) bepaal die maksimum pryse van ingevoerde tee (behalwe "China" en "Darjalo") of los of in pakkies verkoop (behalwe in blikkies) waar dit deur 'n fabrikant aan 'n gelicenseerde handelaar verkoop word, die prys waarteen vertelde tee gewoonlik deur 'n fabrikant aan 'n gelicenseerde handelaar verkoop is op 25 Julie 1941, plus twee pennies per pond.

NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 3 OF THE ANNEXURE TO PROCLAMATION No. 201 OF 1939, AS AMENDED BY PROCLAMATION No. 135 OF 1941.

In terms of Regulation 3, as amended by Proclamation No. 135 of 1941, of the National Emergency Regulations set forth in the annexure to Proclamation No. 201 of 1939, as validated by section two of the War Measures Act, 1940 (Act No. 13 of 1940), and on the recommendation of the National Supplies Control Board, I, RICHARD STUTTAFORD, Minister of Commerce and Industries, do hereby withdraw Section (a) of Government Notice No. 1095, dated the 1st August, 1941, and substitute therefor the following new section (a):—

(a) fix as the maximum prices of imported tea (other than "China" and "Darjalo") whether sold loose or in packets (excluding tins), when sold by a manufacturer to a licensed dealer, the prices at which such tea was ordinarily sold by a manufacturer to a licensed dealer on the 25th July, 1941, plus two pence per pound.
