

#### LANDSNOODTOESTANDREGULASIES.

Die aandag word gevvestig op die feit date—

- (i) ingevolge die bepalings van regulasie 1 van die Unie se Landsnoodtoestandregulasies Duitsland en Italië omskryf word as insluitende enige gebied onder die beheer van die Regering van Duitsland of van Italië; en
- (ii) in gevolge die bepalings van regulasie 8bis (2) van die Unie se Landsnoodtoestandregulasies, niemand sonder die skriftelike toestemming van die Minister van Handel en Nywerheid, hetso direk of indirek enige goedere aan iemand in Duitsland of Italië mag stuur, of enige goedere van iemand in so 'n land mag ontvang of bestel, of enige besigheidstransaksie met iemand in so 'n land mag aangaan nie.

Die bepalings van hierdie regulasies is nou van toepassing op die volgende lande:—

## GOVERNMENT NOTICE

### DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRIES.

The following Government Notice is published for general information:—

#### NATIONAL EMERGENCY REGULATIONS.

Attention is directed to the fact that—

- (i) in terms of the provisions of Regulation 1 of the Union's National Emergency Regulations, Germany and Italy are defined as including any territory under the control of the Government of Germany or of Italy; and
- (ii) in terms of the provisions of Regulation 8bis (2) of the Union's National Emergency Regulations, no person may, without the permission, in writing, of the Minister of Commerce and Industries, either directly or indirectly, send any goods to a person in Germany or Italy, or receive or order any goods from a person in a country as aforesaid, or carry on any business transactions with a person in such country.

The provisions of these regulations now apply to the following countries:—

Germany (including Austria and Czecho-Slovakia).  
Italy and Italian possessions.  
Norway.  
Denmark.  
Holland.  
Belgium.  
Luxembourg.  
The enemy-occupied portions of France.  
The Channel Islands.  
Finland.  
Estonia.  
Latvia.  
Lithuania.  
Danzig.  
Poland.  
Hungary.  
Roumania.  
Yugo-Slavia.  
Bulgaria.  
Greece and the Greek Islands.

Die aandag word ook gevestig op die feit dat, ingevolge die bylae van Oorlogsmaatreël No. 9 van 1940 (Proklamasie No. 246 van 1940), soos gewysig, niemand sonder die skrifte-like toestemming van die Minister van Handel en Nywerheid, hetsy direk of indirek enige goedere aan iemand in 'n beperkte gebied mag ontvang of bestel, of enige besigheids-transaksie met iemand in 'n beperkte gebied mag aangaan nie. Beperkte gebiede is—

- (a) dié gedeelte van Frankryk wat nie deur Duitse of Italiaanse magte beset is nie;
- (b) enige Franse kolonie, besitting of mandaatgebied behalwe Frans Ekwatoriaal Afrika, Frans-Kameroun, Franse besittings in Indië, New-Caledonia, New-Hebrides en Franse besittings in Oceania.

Attention is directed also to the fact that, in terms of the Annexure to War Measure No. 9 of 1940 (Proclamation No. 246 of 1940), as amended, no person may, without the permission, in writing, of the Minister of Commerce and Industries, directly or indirectly, send any goods to a person in a restricted country, receive or order any goods from a person in a restricted country, or carry on any business transactions with a person in a restricted country. Restricted countries are—

- (a) that portion of France which is not occupied by German or Italian forces;
- (b) any French colony, possession or mandated territory except French Equatorial Africa, French Cameroons, French Possessions in India, New Caledonia, New Hebrides and French Possessions in Oceania.
