Ek, JAN CHRISTIAAN SMUTS, Minister van Verdediging, handelende kragtens die bevoegdhede my verleen by regulasie 1 van die regulasies afgekondig by Oorlogsmaatreël No. 6 van 1941 (Proklamasie No. 26 van 1941), verklaar hierby dat die Skoeiselvervaardigingsafdeling van die Leernywerheid 'n beheerde nywerheid in die Unie van Suid-Afrika is.

I, JAN CHRISTIAAN SMUTS, Minister of Defence, acting in terms of the powers conferred upon me by Regulation 1 of the regulations published under War Measure No. 6 of 1941 (Proclamation No. 26 of 1941), hereby declare the Boot and Shoe Manufacturing section of the Leather Industry to be a controlled industry in the Union of South Africa.

BEHEERMAATREELS IN DIE BOUNYWERHEID.

Ek, IVAN LAWRENCE WALKER, Kontroleur van Nywerheidsmannekrag, handelende kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by regulasie 6 van Oorlogsmaatreef No. 6 van 1941 (Proklamasie No. 26 van 1941)—

- (1) verbied hierby enige persoon om sonder my voorafgaande toestemming ondervermelde soort werk, of enige werk in verband daarmee, in die Bounywerheid te verrig:—
- die oprigting van enige gebou of bouwerk waarvan die koste £250 sal oorskry of waarskynlik sal oorskry;
 - die verandering of herstel van enige gebou of bouwerk as die koste van sodanige verandering of herstelwerk, na gelang van die geval, £250 sal oorskry of waarskynlik sal oorskry.

Met dien verstande dat hierdie verbod—

- nie van toepassing is nie op die verrigting van enige werk waarvoor my toestemming ingevolge paragraaf (1) van Goewermentskennisgewing No. 969 van 10 Julie 1941 verkry is;
- in verband met enige sodanige gebou, bouwerk, verandering of herstelwerk, waarvan die koste nie £2,000 sal oorskry of waarskynlik sal oorskry nie, slegs van toepassing is in die gebiede genoem in paragraaf (8) van hierdie kennisgewing, en as daar met sodanige werk voor 17 September 1941 begin is, tree dit op 15 Oktober 1941 in werking;

- (2) vereis hierby dat elke persoon—

- wat die oprigting van enige gebou of bouwerk waarvan die koste £100 maar nie £250 nie sal oorskry of waarskynlik sal oorskry; of
- wat met die verandering of herstel van enige gebou of bouwerk as die koste van sodanige verandering of herstelwerk, na gelang van die geval, £100 maar nie £250 nie, sal oorskry of waarskynlik sal oorskry

in enige gebied genoem in paragraaf (8) van hierdie kennisgewing die naaste Afdelingsinspekteur van Arbeid, binne vier-en-twintig uur nadat met sodanige werk begin is, in kennis moet stel van die adres waar die werk verrig word, die aanvangsdatum daarvan, die aard van die werk, die getal en ambagte van die bouambagsmanne in diens of wat voorgestel word om in diens geneem te word, en die moontlike duur van hulle diens;

- (3) gee hiermee kennis dat aansoeke om my toestemming vir 'n afwyking van die bepalings van paragraaf (1) skriftelik gerig moet word aan die naaste Afdelingsinspekteur van Arbeid. Aansoeke moet ondervermelde besonderhede bevat—

- die adres waar die werk verrig word of waar dit verlang word om 'n aanvang te maak met werk-saamhede;
- naam van eienaar;
- naam van werkgewer;
- getal en ambagte van die bouambagsmanne in diens of wat voorgestel word om in diens geneem te word, en die moontlike duur van hulle diens; en
- in die geval van werk waarmee reeds 'n aanvang gemaak is, die vordering wat met sodanige werk gemaak is op die datum van die aansoek;

- (4) verbied hierby die publikasie in enige nuusblad of tydskrif, of deur hoegenaamd enige middel, van enige advertensie deur enige persoon wat diens aan vakmanne bied of by hulle applikasies vra vir diens in enige vak wat binne die bestek van die Bounywerheid val;

- (5) (a) gelas hierby dat die minimum werksure voorgeskryf in paragrafe (b) en (c) van Goewermentskennisgewing No. 1226 van 29 Augustus 1941 oor ses dae per week versprei moet word;

- (b) gelas hierby elke ambagsman en vakleerling in die Bounywerheid in diens by 'n werkgewer wat geraak word deur Goewermentskennisgewing No. 1226 van 29 Augustus 1941, soos gewysig, om vir minstens 54 uur elke week in die geval van elektrisiëns te werk en vir minstens 51½ uur elke week in die geval van ander ambagsmanne en vakleerlinge, tensy sy werkgewer ingevolge genoemde kennisgewing die toestemming van die Kontroleur verkry

PROHIBITION OF ENGAGEMENT OF JOURNEYMEN
BOATBUILDERS.

I, IVAN LAWRENCE WALKER, Controller of Industrial Man Power, acting in terms of the powers conferred upon me by Regulation 6 (f) of War Measure No. 6 of 1941 (Proclamation No. 26 of 1941), hereby prohibit the engagement without my prior consent, in the Magisterial District of the Cape, of journeymen-boatbuilders by any employer in the Engineering Industry as defined in Government Notice No. 403 of the 19th March, 1941.

CONTROL MEASURES IN THE BUILDING INDUSTRY.

I, IVAN LAWRENCE WALKER, Controller of Industrial Man Power, acting in terms of the powers conferred upon me by Regulation 6 of War Measure No. 6 of 1941 (Proclamation No. 26 of 1941), hereby—

- (1) prohibit any person from performing, without my prior consent, the following type of work, or any work in connection therewith, in the Building Industry—

- the erection of any building or structure the cost of which will exceed or is likely to exceed £250;
- the alteration or repair of any building or structure where the cost of such alteration or repair, as the case may be, will exceed or is likely to exceed £250;

Provided that this prohibition—

- shall not apply to any work for the performance of which any consent has been obtained in terms of paragraph (1) of Government Notice No. 969 of the 10th July, 1941;
- shall, in respect of any such building, structure, alteration or repair, the cost of which will not exceed or is not likely to exceed £2,000, apply only in the areas referred to in paragraph (8) of this notice, and if such work was commenced prior to the 17th September, 1941, shall become operative on the 15th October, 1941;

- (2) require every person who commences—

- the erection of any building or structure the cost of which will exceed or is likely to exceed £100, but not £250; or
- the alteration or repair of any building or structure, where the cost of such alteration or repair, as the case may be, will exceed or is likely to exceed £100, but not £250

in any area referred to in paragraph (8) of this notice to notify the nearest Divisional Inspector of Labour, within twenty-four hours of the commencement of such work, of the address at which the work is being performed, the date on which it was commenced, the nature of the work, the number and trades of the building artisans employed or proposed to be employed, and the probable duration of their employment;

- (3) notify that applications for my consent to a departure from the provisions of paragraph (1) must be addressed in writing to the nearest Divisional Inspector of Labour. Applications shall contain the following particulars—

- the address at which work is being carried on or at which it is desired to commence operations;
- name of owner;
- name of employer;
- number and trades of the building artisans employed or proposed to be employed, and the probable duration of their employment; and
- in the case of work which has already been commenced, the progress which has been made in such work at the date of application;

- (4) prohibit the publication in any newspaper or periodical, or by any means whatsoever, of any advertisement by any person offering employment to or inviting applications for employment from journeymen in any trade falling within the scope of the Building Industry;

- (5) (a) order that the minimum hours of work prescribed in paragraph (b) and (c) of Government Notice No. 1226 of the 29th August, 1941, shall be spread over six days per week;

- (b) order every artisan and apprentice in the Building Industry employed by an employer who is affected by Government Notice No. 1226 of the 29th August, 1941, as amended, to work for not less than 54 hours each week in the case of electricians and for not less than 51½ hours each week in the case of other artisans and apprentices, unless his employer has obtained the consent of the Controller, in terms

- (i) as by die vergunning van sodanige toestemming die Kontroleur die minimum getal ure bepaal het wat elke week gewerk moet word, moet elke betrokke werknemer in elke week vir minstens die getal ure werk wat aldus bepaal is; en
 - (ii) die bepalings van hierdie bevel nie van toepassing op werknemers is wat ouer as vyf-en-veertig jaar is nie, of in enige geval waar 'n werknemer nie in staat is om daaraan te voldoen nie deur omstandighede buite sy beheer;
- (6) gelas dat oortydbesoldiging in die Bounywerheid ten opsigte van enige afsonderlike dag betaalbaar is slegs vir tyd wat gewerk is bo en behalwe die gewone werksure vir daardie dag;
- (7) gelas hierby—
- (a) dat, onderhewig aan die bepalings van enige ooreenkoms ingevolge die Nywerheidsversoeningwet, 1937, geen werkgewer in die Bounywerheid, sonder my voorafgaande toestemming, enige ambagsman in enige ambag wat binne die bestek van die Bounywerheid val, besoldiging teen 'n hoër skaal mag betaal as die skaal waarop sodanige ambagsman, of deur dieselfde of deur enige ander werkgewer, op die datum van hierdie kennisgewing besoldig is; en
 - (b) dat geen sodanige ambagsman besoldiging mag aanneem teen 'n hoër skaal as dié waarop hy ingevolge paragraaf (a) geregtig is nie.
- (8) Die bepalings van paragraaf (1), in sover hulle op enige gebou, bouwerk, verandering of herstelwerk van toepassing is, waarvan die koste nie £2,000 sal oorskry of waarskynlik sal oorskry nie, en die bepalings van paragraaf (2), is op ondervermelde gebiede van toepassing, nl. :—

Kaaprovinsie.—Die magistraatsdistrikte Albany, die Kaap, Paarl, Wynberg, Simonstad, Bellville (met uitsondering van die munisipale gebied Durbanville), Kimberley, Oos-Londen, Port Elizabeth en Queenstown.

Oranje-Vrystaat.—Die magistraatsdistrik Bloemfontein.

Transvaal.—Die magistraatsdistrikte Johannesburg, Germiston, Boksburg, Benoni, Brakpan, Springs, Nigel en Heidelberg, die gebied binne 'n omtrek van 30 myl vanaf die Hoofposkantoor, Krugersdorp, die gebied binne 'n omtrek van 20 myl vanaf die Hoofposkantoor, Vereeniging, die gebied binne 'n omtrek van 20 myl vanaf die Hoofposkantoor, Pretoria, en die gebiede binne 'n omtrek van 10 myl vanaf die Hoofposkantore onderskeidelik op Witbank, Middelburg, Klerksdorp en Potchefstroom.

Natal.—Die gebied binne 'n omtrek van 17 myl vanaf die Hoofposkantoor, Durban, en die gebied binne 'n omtrek van 25 myl vanaf die Hoofposkantoor, Pietermaritzburg.

Ander gebiede.—Enige ander magistraatsdistrik waarin werk verrig word in verband met die oprigting, voltooiing, hernuwing, herstel of verandering van enige gebou of bouwerk wat gebruik word of bedoel word om gebruik te word vir enige amptelike doel verbonde aan die voortsetting van die oorlog.

- (9) Vir die toepassing van hierdie kennisgewing—
- (a) beteken „Bounywerheid”, dié nywerheid soos omskryf in Goewermentskennisgewing No. 968 van 10 Julie 1941;
 - (b) word die koste van oprigting, verandering of herstel van enige gebou of bouwerk geag die totale bedrag te wees wat daarvoor betaal of betaalbaar is deur die eienaar van die gebou of bouwerk of deur die persoon op wie se bevel die werk onderneem is.

of the said notice, to the employment of such employee for less than 54 hours a week or 5½ hours a week, as the case may be: Provided that—

- (i) if in granting such consent the Controller has specified the minimum number of hours to be worked each week, every employee affected shall in each week work for not less than the number of hours so specified; and
 - (ii) the provisions of this order shall not apply to employees over the age of fifty-five years, or in any case where an employee is unable to comply therewith through circumstances beyond his control;
- (6) order that in the Building Industry, overtime remuneration shall, in respect of any one day, be payable only for time worked in excess of the ordinary hours of work for that day;
- (7) order—
- (a) that, subject to the provisions of any agreement under the Industrial Conciliation Act, 1937, no employer in the Building Industry shall, except with my prior consent, pay any artisan in any trade falling within the scope of the Building Industry remuneration at a higher rate than the rate at which such artisan was being remunerated, whether by the same or any other employer, at the date of this notice; and
 - (b) that no such artisan shall accept remuneration at a higher rate than that to which he is entitled under paragraph (a).
- (8) The provisions of paragraph (1), in so far as they apply to any building, structure, alteration or repair, the cost of which will not exceed or is not likely to exceed £2,000, and the provisions of paragraph (2) shall apply in the following areas, viz. :—

Cape Province.—The Magisterial Districts of Albany, the Cape, Paarl, Wynberg, Simonstown, Bellville (excluding the Municipal Area of Durbanville), Kimberley, East London, Port Elizabeth and Queenstown.

Orange Free State.—The Magisterial District of Bloemfontein.

Transvaal.—The Magisterial Districts of Johannesburg, Germiston, Boksburg, Benoni, Brakpan, Springs, Nigel and Heidelberg, the area within a 30-mile radius of the General Post Office, Krugersdorp, the area within a 20-mile radius of the General Post Office, Vereeniging, the area within a 20-mile radius of the General Post Office, Pretoria, and the areas within a 10-mile radius of the General Post Offices at Witbank, Middelburg, Klerksdorp and Potchefstroom, respectively.

Natal.—The area within a radius of 17 miles of the General Post Office, Durban, and the area within a radius of 25 miles of the General Post Office, Pietermaritzburg.

Other Areas.—Any other magisterial district in which work is being performed in connection with the erection, completion, renovation, repair or alteration of any building or structure used or intended to be used for any official purpose connected with the prosecution of the war.

- (9) For the purposes of this notice—
- (a) "Building Industry" means that industry as defined in Government Notice No. 968 of the 10th July, 1941;
 - (b) the cost of erection, alteration or repair of any building or structure shall be deemed to be the total amount paid or payable therefor by the owner of the building or structure or by the person on whose instructions the work was undertaken.
