CONTROL OF JUTE GOODS.

I, Hermanus Johannes Geyer Kenney, Controller of Jute Goods, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Government Notice No. 2531 of the 29th November, 1946, as amended by Government Notice No. 438 of the 28th February, 1947, and by direction under regulation 22 of War Measure No. 146 of 1942, as amended, do hereby order as follows:—

The regulations published under Government Notice No. 461 of 23rd February, 1951, are hereby amended by—

(1) adding the following new sub-paragraph at the end of regulation 8:—

"(e) For the purpose of sub-paragraph (c) of this regulation 'supplier' means any market or commission agent but does not include a municipal market master or municipal market auctioneer except when a municipal market master, in addition to his functions as such, also acts as a market or commission agent.";

(2) adding the following new regulation after regulation 8:—

"8 bis. (1) The Municipal Market Masters of Johannesburg and Pretoria shall furnish the Controller or his nominee twice per week or as the Controller may otherwise direct, with statements clearly setting out the following information in respect of bagged goods sold on their respective markets:—

- Date of sale.
- Number of bags of goods sold.
- Type(s) and size(s) of bags in which the goods were contained.
- Name of the market or commission agent(s) concerned in each sale.

(2) Market or commission agents shall surrender bag coupons to the Controller or his nominee at such times and places as the Controller may direct, in respect of all goods sold on their behalf on the Johannesburg and Pretoria Municipal Markets in accordance with the information furnished by the market master in terms of the preceding sub-paragraph.

Ek, Hermanus Johannes Geyer Kenney, Kontroleur van Jutegoedere, gelas hierby, kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by Goewermentskennisgewing No. 2531 van 29 November 1946, soos gewysig by Goewermentskennisgewing No. 438 van 28 Februarie 1947, en ingevolge regulasie 22 van Oorlogsmaatreel No. 146 van 1942, soos gewysig, as volg:—

Die regulasies wat by Goewermentskennisgewing No. 461 van 23 Februarie 1951 gepubliseer is, word hierby gewysig deur—

(1) die volgende nuwe subparagraaf aan die einde van regulasie 8 by te voeg:—

"(e) Vir die toepassing van subparagraaf (c) van hierdie regulasie beteken 'verskaffer' 'n mark- of kommissie-agent maar nie 'n munisipale markmeester of munisipale markfelaar nie, behalwe wanneer 'n munisipale markmeester, benewens sy funksies as sodanig, ook as 'n mark- of kommissie-agent optree.";

(2) die volgende nuwe regulasie na regulasie 8 by te voeg:—

"8 bis. (1) Die munisipale markmeester van Johannesburg en Pretoria moet die Kontroleur of sy benoemde twee keer per week of so dikwels as wat die Kontroleur mag bepaal, voorsien van opgawes wat die volgende inligting ten opsigte van goedere wat in sakke, op hul onderskeie markte verkoop is, duidelik meld:—

- Datum van verkoop.
- Getal sakke wat goedere bevat het wat verkoop is.
- Soort(e) en grootte(s) van sakke waarin die goedere was.
- Naam van die mark- of kommissie agent(e) betrokke by elke verkoop.

(2) Mark- of kommissie-agente moet oj die tye en plekke wat die Kontroleur mag bepaal, sakkoepsels aan die Kontroleur o sy benoemde oorhandig ten opsigte van alle goedere wat namens hulle op die Johannesburgse en Pretoriase munisipale mark verkoop is in ooreenstemming met di inligting wat die markmeester ooreenkoms met die bepalings van die voorafgaande sub paragraaf verstrek het.

(3) Upon receipt of bag coupons from market or commission agents in terms of the preceding sub-paragraph, the Controller or his nominee shall issue receipts therefor which will entitle the market or commission agent concerned to obtain on behalf of his principals, empty bags to the number mentioned in such receipt from an official bag issue depot."
